

LEVEL I PHYSICIANS' ACCREDITATION REGISTRATION

The Division of Workers' Compensation is pleased to announce that physicians may attend and test at a one-day seminar or complete the home study process by testing at state and community/junior college campuses throughout Colorado. Level I Accreditation, for physicians providing primary care to patients with "time-loss injuries," is designed to assist you in understanding your administrative, legal and medical role in the Colorado Workers' Compensation system.

Upon completion of this course, medical practitioners should be able to:

1. Define and assess Maximum Medical Improvement for patients who have work-related injuries or medical conditions.
2. Describe medical/ethical issues pertaining to workers' compensation cases.
3. List the principles of risk assessment used to determine causality and apply them to a clinical case.
4. With regard to reviewing, generating or releasing medical records, explain how the waiver of the doctor/patient privilege in a workers' comp case is applied.
5. Explain and apply the general principles of the Colorado Division of Workers' Compensation Medical Treatment Guidelines.

To register to become Level I Accredited, fill out and return the Registration Form on the back. **Please indicate on the Registration Form your preference to attend a seminar or complete the home study process. Be sure to give us three test dates if you chose the home study process.** Typically we present one seminar per year. Upon receipt of your registration, you will receive a confirmation letter according to the process selected. If you select home study, the curriculum will be mailed and you will be notified of your test date.

Seminar participants who are licensed under the Medical Practice Act may earn Continuing Medical Education units through the Division of Workers' Compensation/University of Colorado-Denver School of Medicine. **The University of Colorado School of Medicine is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education to sponsor continuing medical education for physicians. The University of Colorado School of Medicine designates this educational activity for a maximum of 7.5 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™.** Physicians should only claim credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity. Chiropractors may earn CEUs as applicable through the Board of Chiropractic Examiners.
