Eligibility Requirement: Possession of a Bachelor's or Master's Degree*.

Duties: Receives training in introductory governmental work in the following: Audits payroll and time records of employers for compliance with state and federal wage and hour laws and regulations; investigates complaints and interviews employees, employers and other persons or agencies concerning complaints; collects statistical data in surveys of wage rates and hours worked in various occupations and industries; initiates and conducts fact finding conferences; transcribes claims for wages when such are found due under existing laws; prepares reports and assembles evidence for hearings or court cases; conducts cost of living surveys as required; performs related duties as required. Position involves extensive travel.

Note: Eligible fluent bi-lingual individuals are encouraged to apply.

Career Progression: After successful and satisfactory completion of a one (1) year training period the individual will advance to Wage and Hour Investigator 1 (SH-19).

Funding: It is expected that funding for position(s) is available through December 31, 2015.

Special Requirement: Incumbents in this class are required to travel.

Important: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.

*You do not have to supply evidence of your degree (an official college/university transcript) with your application package. However, this information will be required before a bona fide offer can be made. If your degree is from outside of the United States, you must submit certification from an accreditation services agency. The accreditation services agency must certify that your degree equates to a bachelor's or master's degree from an accredited American school or university.
