

## January 2014 Housing for Entering Premedical, Preveterinary & BS/BA Students

Students in the Premedical, Preveterinary and BS or BA Programs are required to live in University housing for their first year, with the exception of students who are residents of Grenada (married students with children, mature students or students with pets may also be exempt with authorization from the housing office). The entering student housing form is a contractual agreement subject to the University's Housing Cancellation Policy. Enrolled students will be provided with housing forms for the following term in the fall.

### **Students entering the Premedical, Preveterinary, and BS or BA Program in January 2014 will be housed on the True Blue Campus\***

Our dorms on the True Blue campus are centrally air conditioned. Entering students are housed in residence halls which accommodate nine persons in same-sex suites. These suites consist of three triple occupancy bedrooms and a common kitchen area. Each bedroom has a full bathroom. The kitchen is equipped with a sink, stove and refrigerator. Each suite has its own washer and dryer. Electricity is 220 volts.

Bedrooms are furnished with beds, chairs, desks, closet space and bookshelves. Students must provide their own linens (beds are single size, standard length). The common area is furnished with a dining table. Students must bring their own tableware and cutlery.

**Triple with Air Conditioning: US \$2,480.00/term**

The dormitories will officially open on January 9, 2014. **Students are expected to arrive on campus in time for mandatory orientation commencing on January 15, 2014.** Students are expected to vacate their rooms no later than two days after the posting of results of the Academic Progress Committee meetings scheduled for December 16. Students are allowed to leave after their final exam scheduled on May 9, 2014 (with the exception of final term premed/prevet students who are scheduled to sit the PSCE on May 12, 2014).

Roommates will be assigned and you will be notified to your SGU email account in December. Roommate requests will be honored until November 15, 2013 and need to be submitted either on the housing form or in writing by **both** students to the Freshman Housing Coordinator via fax +1 631-665-5590 or email [FreshmanHousing@sgu.edu](mailto:FreshmanHousing@sgu.edu). Entering students cannot request to live with upper classmen. You may contact [FreshmanHousing@sgu.edu](mailto:FreshmanHousing@sgu.edu) if you have questions about your housing assignment.

Note: Roommate assignments are subject to change prior to your arrival on the island.

***PLEASE NOTE ALL DORMITORIES AND BUILDINGS ARE SMOKE FREE. No animals are allowed in the dormitories. Students are prohibited from bringing extra furniture or additional electrical appliances of any kind (such as refrigerator, microwave, hot plate, toaster oven, heating or cooling unit) into their room or suite. Each dorm room will be inspected at the beginning and end of each term. A damage fee will be charged to your account for any damage done to your room or apartment during the term. Personal belongings will not be insured by the University for any flood, theft, fire or natural disasters. Therefore it is advised that all residents insure their personal belongings.***

During their second term, students must enter a housing lottery if they wish to live on campus for their next term. However, upon promotion to the MD or DVM, first term students are required to live on campus and at that time can contract to remain in campus housing for the following term. The University reserves the right to require students to live on campus for the basic science years.

### **OFF-CAMPUS HOUSING**

You are eligible to seek off-campus housing if you are married (with or without children), bringing pets with you, going beyond your second term, or have received special permission through the housing office. In the event you are eligible for off-campus housing, you may obtain a list of University approved housing upon request. This housing is not sponsored by the University.

### **ALTERNATIVE HOUSING**

In the event rooms are not available on the True Blue Campus at the time of move-in, the University will house affected students in an alternative housing location.
