The Board cannot process incomplete applications. If any item is missing, incomplete or incorrect, your application cannot be reviewed by the Board. Incomplete applications are void after one year. Furthermore, because application information is time sensitive, documents cannot be transferred from old applications to new applications.

□ <b>NOTARIZED APPLICATION:</b> The complete application must be mailed to the Board's office at the address listed above, along with your <b>FEE.</b> You must sign the application in the presence of a notary.
□ <b>CITIZENSHIP/QUALIFIED ALIEN STATUS</b> : Please submit a copy of your current Secure and Verifiable Document(s) such as driver's license, passport, or document as indicated on pages 10 & 11 of this application.
□ <b>OTHER STATE LICENSURE CERTIFICATION:</b> If you are or have ever been licensed in another state, please have that state(s) officially certify that license to the Board's office. A letter of certification from EACH state in which you were issued a license must be sent.
□ <b>EDUCATION:</b> All applicants are required to present proof that he or she a minimum of 7th grade education (copy of high school diploma, high school or college transcript).
☐ SUBMIT APPLICATION IN A 9X12 or LARGER ENVELOPE – Do not staple pages or check/money order. Do not fold pages of the application.

Applicants who do not qualify according to O.C.G.A. § 43-7-17 will be required to take the Georgia Master Barber Examination.

Georgia does not endorse licenses from Alabama, California, Washington, D.C., Hawaii, Nevada, New York, Washington, and Oklahoma. For all other states, endorsement will be granted or denied on an individual basis in accordance with the law. O.C.G.A. § 43-7-17(d) states: "The board may issue a license to practice under this chapter by endorsement, without examination, to persons having licenses under similar laws of another state if, in the opinion of the board, the standards and qualifications for licensure in that state are comparable to those in this state for the particular license applied for."
