In the latter part of 1879, Cleveland erected a monument to recognize the service of their soldiers and sailors who participated in the Civil War. At the dedication there were hundreds of men in the honor procession. The Sixth Regiment, Uniformed Rank Independent Order of Odd Fellows, led the First Brigade of the Fourth Division. Captain R. W. Drackett assisted the Colonel. There were 300 Odd Fellows who marched in the procession.
