Steer Show/Carcass Merit Contest:

All steers are automatically entered into both the Steer Show and Carcass Merit Contest. All steers will be weighed and ultrasound-scanned Saturday afternoon following the Western Star Steer Show. Steers will not be clipped, but the technician will use oil. Steers should be clean with minimal back hair for the best scan results. To clean up your steer after scanning, absorb the oil with cornstarch or baby powder, then blow it out BEFORE heading to the washrack.

Steers will be evaluated on two grids: a quality grid and a muscle/cutability grid. The Steer Show and Carcass Merit Contest are independent contests and have no bearing on each other. The scan data will be sent to the CUP Lab, and the winners of each grid will be announced on the NDSA website and through the mail.

Supreme Champion Female:

Following the last breed class, the champion and reserve heifers from each breed will compete for Supreme Heifer honors. The Supreme Heifer will receive \$350 cash and a prize, Reserve Supreme Heifer will receive \$150 and a prize, and Third-, Fourth- and Fifth-Place Overall Heifers will each receive \$50 and a prize.
