Colonel James M. Sims Memorial Scholarship 2013 College Scholarship

Background: The Colonel James M. Sims Memorial Scholarship Fund is a component fund of the Community Foundation of Greater Birmingham (CFGB) and presents the Colonel James M. Sims Memorial Scholarship to deserving Marines through the generosity of Col. Sims and his family. The scholarship is meant to be a living testament to the memory of Col. Sims' honorable service in the United States Marine Corps Reserve (USMCR). At his retirement from the USMCR in September 1981, Col. Sims had completed 29 years, three months and three days of qualifying Federal Service time, attending every scheduled drill. Most of this service was as a member of the 4th Battalion, 14th Marines, 4th Marine Division. The guidelines and criteria for scholarship selection are in keeping with Col. Sims' superb service to this Battalion and to the USMCR.

Amount: \$500 to \$1,000 per year to a member of the Marine Corps Reserve, 4th Marine Division, Antiterrorism Battalion. Once awarded, scholarships are renewable for up to four years (eight semesters) as long as the student maintains a 2.0 GPA (on 4.0 GPA scale), is a fulltime student at an accredited college, remains in good standing in the unit (no UAs or disciplinary problems) or receives an honorable discharge on completion of 6 years of obligated service, and as long as the Scholarship Fund has sufficient resources. Scholarships will be paid directly to the college.

Applicant criteria:

- Be a member in good standing of the Marine Corps Reserve, 4th Marine Division, Antiterrorism Battalion
- Be enrolled as a fulltime student (course load of 12 hours per semester) and making satisfactory progress towards a degree in an accredited college
- Be a citizen of the United States of America
- Maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA on 4.0 GPA scale
