GENERAL INFORMATION

SUMMER FAMILY CAMP

Since 1960, week-long camping programs for families have become a tradition for many. In 2015, YMCA Camp du Nord will offer 13 weeks of Family Camp, with a shortened "mini-week" during the last week. Staff supervised activities for every age are offered in the mornings and a variety of program options for family time are available in the afternoons and evenings. The shores of Burntside Lake provide lasting family memories, allowing for outdoor adventures, family growth, and a whole lot of laughter.

Arrival on Saturday evening allows time to settle into your cabin/site prior to our program beginning on Sunday morning. Your week begins with an equipment demonstration and orientation. The rest of the week is packed full of fun family activities and programs to promote outdoor adventure and family time together. Participation in all activities, except equipment demonstrations and orientation, are optional. Participate in as much or as little as you please. It's your vacation!

LODGING

YMCA Camp du Nord consists of 33 unique cabins, 7 auto tent and rustic tent sites, and 2 platform tents. Cabins come in a variety of sizes, sleeping two to sixteen people. Tent sites can accommodate eight people and platform cabins/tents sleep six people.

All sites are available for use by families, individuals or groups. The unique character of each of YMCA Camp du Nord's cabins and tent sites offers a variety of lodging that appeals to all levels of comfort in the wilderness.

Cabins provide a variety of queen, full, bunk and long twin beds. All of the cabins have kitchens, water, and electricity, with the exception of our five new "off-the-grid" platform cabins in Pine Pointe and du Nord Villages.

Many of the cabins have bathrooms; and others utilize outdoor biffies and the central shower house.

MEAL SERVICE — Not your average camp food!

Hearty and nutritious meals are available in camp's dining hall for an added fee. Meals together at camp provide wonderful community interaction. With proper registration and advance notice, our staff can accommodate most dietary needs or restrictions. See our website for a sample menu. Breakfast is served from 8:00–8:45 a.m., lunch at 12:30 p.m. and dinner at 5:30 p.m. Pricing and registration for meals can be found on page 13.

AGE GROUP ACTIVITIES

Imagine two and a half hours enjoying time on the deck, hiking up to Old Baldy, paddling on Burntside Lake (the list could go on), all the while knowing that your kids are having fun with our staff, allowing you some much needed time off! Our Age Group program provides just this and is truly what sets Camp du Nord apart from other family vacation destinations. From 9:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m., our staff provide fun and educational activities for kids ages 0–18. Our under 4 year old age groups are located in one of two indoor/outdoor play spaces, and all other age groups spend time exploring the beauty of Camp du Nord. Children have opportunities for age appropriate activities, including creative arts, sports, environmental education, group games, and outdoor skill building. Optional adult age group activities are also offered by our Resource Families and include an active and non-active option each day! Snack is provided for ages 2–13. Age groups are formed by age and vary in size each week, depnding on camper numbers.

Mini-Week Opportunities: This summer du Nord has a rare 13th week of camp! Please join us for our first ever mini-week. Enjoy full summer programming in an abridged Saturday-Thursday sampler. This is a great opportunity to 'try out' the du Nord experience at a discounted rate. Stick around through Labor Day if you want to enjoy the 4th annual Fest du Nord Music Festival and Camp du Nord's 55th Anniversary Celebration (registration for this event will be out in April, 2015).

Reservation fees published include all programs, use of facilities and use of equipment. Some arts and crafts projects have an additional materials fee, as do cookouts and overnights.

Please note: Exceeding cabin or tent site capacity by one person only of any age is permissible at a fee of \$135. (No fee for three years old or younger.)

RUSTIC LAKESIDE TENT SITES

These beautiful campsites are located near the lake and require that camping equipment be carried to the site. A 12'x16' platform is provided for your tent. Each site has space for eight people. A picnic table and fire ring are also provided. Biffies are located nearby. There is a centrally located shower house with modern bathroom conveniences. These sites do not have any type of electrical hookups, but there is nearby refrigeration and food storage available. Dishes and cookware are not provided. Sites: **BALDY, SENTINELS & DRUIDS \$460/wk** (rope is needed to tie down tent)

AUTO TENT SITES

The auto tent sites are conveniently positioned near the center of the camp. There is a centrally located shower house with modern bathroom conveniences. Each site has space for eight people per site in pop-up trailers or tents. These sites have limited electrical hookups. A picnic table, nearby refrigeration and food storage are available. Campers are allowed to keep vehicles at theses sites. Dishes and cookware are not provided. Sites: **SLIM LAKE, COXEY POND, HEGMAN LAKE & OLE LAKE \$460/wk**

PLATFORM TENT SITES

Each platform tent sleeps six and has a covered picnic table area and fire ring. Biffies are located nearby. These camping sites do not have any type of electrical hookups. Nearby refrigeration, food storage, showers and water spigot are available. Each platform tent has 1 double bed and 2 bunk beds. Dishes and cookware are provided by camp. **WOLF AND BEAR**

Located in du Nord Village.

PLATFORM CABINS

Enjoy one of our "off-the-grid" eco-cabins. These newer cabins are simple, yet very comfortable. A screened porch with picnic table and stainless steel table make outdoor cooking a breeze. The sleeping room includes 2 elevated long twin over queen bunkbeds. Nearby water spigot, showers, biffies, and refrigeration are available. Solar lanterns and all dishware and cooking utensils are provided.

DU TRIPS

– Du Trip Participant

DESCRIPTION

The purpose of du Trips is to provide opportunities for families to expand their outdoor experience in the north woods. Trained staff provides guidance and leadership for a whole family adventure, where your family will develop leadership skills, enjoy wilderness immersion, and have fun and meaningful family time!

REGISTRATION

In its 3rd year as a program, du Trips will be run as a week-long experience from Saturday to Saturday, beginning and ending at du Nord, with a 2-4 night canoe trip into the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness during your week. Arrive on Saturday night, take in a few nights of family camp while you prepare for your adventure, enjoy a quality canoe experience with a trained staff member, and return on time for closing celebration on Friday night! Du Trips families will be provided housing at the Platform Tent, Grosbeak, in Pine Pointe Village.



LOTTERY

There will be a du Trips Lottery on December 6, 2014. This Lottery will be independent of du Nord's summer camp Lottery. You may register for both a du Trip and a family camping experience! Indicate on your registration whether you would like to receive a phone call on Lottery Day 2014 for the chance to register for a du Trip.

OPEN ENROLLMENT

Beginning December 19, 2014 all available remaining trips will be open for enrollment on a first come, first served basis. At this point there will be additional flexibility regarding specific dates for du Trips experiences.

LOTTERY REGISTRATION

On summer program fills fast. Your best chance to get the cabin/ site and dates you want is to participate in the Lottery. **The Lottery Day is Saturday, December 6, 2014.** Staff will contact you after 8 a.m. to place your reservation. **You must be available by phone this day!**

In order to participate in the Lottery, submit a Lottery registration and \$150 deposit, due to the YMCA Customer Service Center located at 2125 East Hennepin Avenue, Suite 100, Minneapolis, MN 55413, by **midnight on Wednesday, November 26, 2014.** Online Lottery registration is also available at **dunord.org.**

There is a \$150 deposit per site or cabin and must be paid via credit or debit card. CHECKS WILL NOT be accepted during the Lottery process. Once a reservation has been made, the deposit is nonrefundable. **The deposit will not be processed until a reservation has been made on Lottery Day.**

Half of the remaining balance for your reservation is due to the YMCA Customer Service Center by February 13, 2015. Your credit/debit card will be charged on this date if indicated on the registration form.

If you are new to the Lottery process, please indicate this on the registration. A staff member or volunteer will contact you prior to the Lottery to assist you and answer any questions.

PROCEDURES FOR MULTIPLE FAMILIES WANTING MULTIPLE CABINS/SITES

During the Lottery process, up to three families may be linked together by writing each other's family name on the bottom of the registration forms. Families must attend the same week and all family names must match.

When a registration form is pulled on Lottery Day, that family may reserve up to three cabins/sites and the remaining families will not be called. You may put the same phone number that is to be called on all forms so only one person will be called. Camp will bill one cabin/site to each family unless otherwise noted.

PROCEDURES FOR MULTIPLE FAMILIES SHARING ONE CABIN/SITE

Families wanting to share a cabin or site, please designate one family as the party responsible for all payments. The other families sharing, should in turn, make their payments to the designated family. If no family is designated to handle the payments, the payment responsibility will default to the family name under which the reservation was made. Each family may submit a Lottery form.

OPEN ENROLLMENT

Beginning **December 19, 2014**, all available cabins/sites remaining after Lottery Day will be open for enrollment on a first-come, firstserved basis. During Open Enrollment, reservations can be made by mail, fax or at dunord.org. Please visit dunord.org for a weekly availability chart.

A deposit equal to 50% of your total lodging fee must accompany your reservation. Checks and money orders are accepted during Open Enrollment. **Reservations will not be made without payment.** The remaining balance is due one month before your visit to camp. If you have indicated on your registration form to charge your credit/debit card, it will be charged on this date.

CONFIRMATION & BILLING

Lottery Enrollment: Once your reservation has been made and deposit posted to your account, a confirmation/billing for 50% of the reservation fee balance will be sent in January.

All Enrollment: An invoice for the remaining amount due on your reservation will be sent approximately 6 to 8 weeks before you attend camp. The invoice will include the balance for the reservation, meal service fees, and any other additional fees incurred. This final payment is due at the YMCA Customer Service Center 1 month prior to your visit to camp.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations made one month or less before your camp session start date are non-refundable and non-transferable. Changes in site reservation made within one month of camp will be charged a \$25 change fee.

Fall, winter and spring are times of change in the north woods! Fall brings vibrant colors and active wildlife. Winter hosts the bright sun and fresh snow. Risks include, but are not limited to, broken bones, torn ligaments or other injuries as a result of falls or contact with other participants; death as a result of drowning or brain damage caused by near drowning in pools or other bodies of water; medical conditions resulting from physical activity; and damaged clothing or other property. I understand such risks simply cannot be eliminated, despite the use of safety equipment,without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity.

- 2. I expressly accept and assume all of the risks inherent in this activity or that might have been caused by the negligence of the Releasees. My/My child's participation in these activities is purely voluntary and we elect to participate despite the risks. In addition, if at any time I believe that event conditions are unsafe or that I or my child are unable to participate due to physical or medical conditions, then I will immediately discontinue participation.
- 3. I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless Releasees from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action which are in any way connected with my/my child's participation in these activities, or our use of their equipment or facilities, arising from negligence. This release does not apply to claims arising from intentional conduct or conduct that constitutes greater than ordinary negligence. Should Releasees or anyone acting on their behalf be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs.
- 4. I represent that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I or my child may suffer or cause while participating in this activity, or else I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage myself. I further represent that I/my child have no medical or physical conditions which could interfere with our safety in these activities, or else I am willing to assume and bear the costs of all risks that may be created, directly or indirectly, by any such condition.
- In the event that I file a lawsuit, I agree to do so in the state where Releasees' facility is located, and I further agree that the substantive law of that state shall apply.
 I agree that if any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining

portions shall remain in full force and effect.

- PARENT/GUARDIAN AUTHORIZATION SECTION TRANSPORTATION/MEDICAL
- In the event that I/my child need immediate medical attention for injuries received while participating in a YMCA program, I authorize the YMCA staff to give me or my child reasonable first aid, and to arrange transport of myself or my child to a health care facility for emergency services as needed.
- I give permission for myself and/or my child to be transported by the YMCA as needed for field trips, inclement weather, or late pick up. I also give my permission to participate in walking field trips.
- I also give permission for myself or my child to enter Canada with the YMCA. I also understand that I/my child will need to bring our passport to camp if the trip involves such travel to Canada.
- 4. I hereby acknowledge that the YMCA will assume that either parent of the child may pick up the child at any time during the program unless there is pertinent court documentation on file at the YMCA that indicates otherwise.
- 5. I agree to the release of any records necessary for treatment, referral, billing or insurance purposes. The YMCA receives medical information on campers/ participants that may need to be shared with medical providers.
- 6. If I or my child requires use and administration of an epi-pen, prescription or over the counter medication, it is my responsibility to ensure that the epi-pen and/or medication are on me or my child or within our personal belongings every day of the program. If YMCA staff is required to administer and use the epi-pen and/or medication, I agree to forever release and discharge the YMCA and its directors, officers, and employees from any and all liability arising out of or resulting from use or administration of the epi-pen and/or medication.

GENERAL

- I hereby release all pictures of myself or my child taken by the YMCA for promotional purposes and programming materials including the YMCA website.
- I give my permission for the YMCA to administer sunscreen as needed and to change my child's diaper while my child is in their care.
- I acknowledge that certain sections of this waiver may not apply to me and/ or my child and the programs or activities that we have chosen but agree to be bound by any applicable language.
- By signing this document, I agree that if I or my child is hurt or our property is damaged during participation in these activities, then I or my child may be found by a court of law to have waived our right to maintain a lawsuit against the parties being released on the basis of any claim for negligence.

I have had sufficient time to read this entire document and, should I choose to do so, consult with legal counsel prior to signing. Also, I understand that this activity might not be made available to me or that the cost to engage in this activity would be significantly greater if the YMCA did not utilize waivers as a method to lower insurance and administrative costs. I have read and understood this document and I agree to be bound by its terms.





