Summer 2015	April 15 through June 30, 2015

Important Items to Remember

- Student must have been in Michigan foster care on or after their 13th birthday.
- · There is no upper age limit.
- · Student must be attending a Michigan public or private degree granting 4-year college/university or a community college.
- Funding only can be used for the following: Tuition, fees, room/board, books, and supplies/equipment required for enrollment.
- Can only be used for computers (or other electronic devices) the institution has a written statement that the device is required for enrollment.
- Funding only can be used for undergraduate students; not available for graduate students.
- · This funding can be used along with ETV.
- · This funding may impact eligibility for other tuition specific aid such as the TIP program.

There is no maximum amount, but must be for a specific <u>unmet need</u> for the following: Tuition, fees, room, board, books, supplies and equipment required for enrollment.

Required Documentation

Financial aid award letter (not award summary or history)
Tuition bill (actual cost of tuition for the semester you are applying)
Most recent grade report
Documentation supporting any off-campus expense (rental agreement, meal plan cost etc.)
Fees (include names/cost of fees)
Books (include names/cost of books)
Supplies (include names/cost of supplies)
