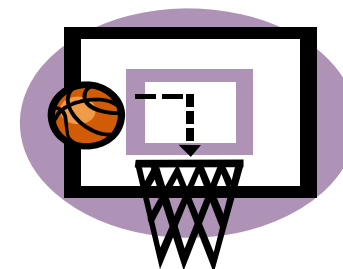

We will focus on learning and improving the fundamentals of basketball while having a great time. Age appropriate equipment will be used to ensure that all players develop good habits as they practice their basic skills.

Drew is currently a Guidance Counselor at The Bromfield School. Drew holds a Master's degree in School Counseling from Assumption College and a Bachelor of Arts degree in Communications from Marist College. He has taught at St. Peter Marian Jr.-Sr. High School, St. Bernard's Central Catholic High School, and Holy Name Jr.-Sr. High School. While at St. Peter Marian he coached the Girls Freshman basketball team. Drew attended Shepherd Hill Regional High School in Dudley, MA where he played basketball for four years.

August 8-12 Director Josh Thurston

Josh graduated from The Bromfield School in 2004. At Bromfield, Josh was a member of the Varsity Basketball team. In 2003, the team earned the title of District Champions and were State Finalists. This past year, Josh was the Assistant Varsity Basketball coach at Nashoba Regional High School in Bolton. Currently, he is the head coach of a 5th grade Boys AAU Basketball Team which plays in tournaments across Massachusetts.

During all sessions, members from both boys and girls teams at Bromfield, will serve as coaching assistants ensuring a low player/coach ratio.

Features

- Instruction in basketball fundamentals by our teaching staff. Our low player/coach ratio ensures maximum staff attention. Individual help is consistently available.
- Two games per day. Each participant plays a minimum of half of each game. Players are grouped by age and playing experience.
- Skill stations each day emphasize fundamentals needed to succeed in basketball. Special focus is given to improving shooting skills.
- Each player receives a camp t-shirt**, certificate of participation, and self-help guide to assist in practicing skills learned at clinic.
