ACT Boot Camp

Are you getting ready to take the ACT test and would like to be better prepared? During this ACT Boot Camp, students will learn both over-arching and specific strategies to overcome the tricks and traps of the test. The ultimate goal of this course is to help students increase their overall score. Students will be engaged with two-way material, real-life examples, and short quizzes to test newly-learned concepts from the English, Math, Reading, Science, and Writing Sections. An important, but optional mock test will be held before the boot camp, so students have a baseline to gage their progress.
