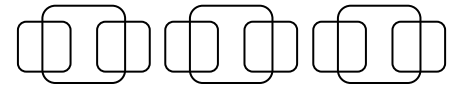


General Information

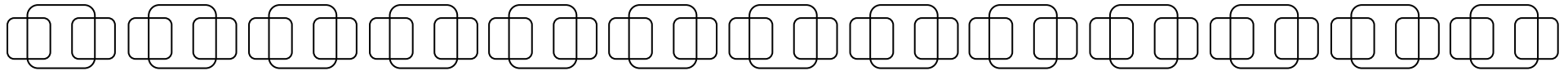
