[♦] For transfer to a four-year institution, students are strongly advised to take MATH 102 instead of MATH 101. Students must seek the assistance of their advisor to determine the appropriate mathematics course.

Students must meet pre-requisites before taking any given course. Students must earn a minimum grade of "C" in each required course and have a minimum 2.00 GPA to earn a credential. All BPCC students are expected to be familiar with College policies, requirements, procedures and regulations. Students must assume final responsibility for being acquainted with College policies.
