Students must meet prerequisites before taking any given course.

Students must earn a minimum grade of "C" or higher in each required course and have a minimum 2.00 GPA to earn a credential.

Students must meet the general education competencies for the academic certificate. Certificate students must test out of READ 099, into ENGL 101, and into MATH 099 as documented by ACT, placement tests, or course completion.

Music majors are required to take a music theory placement exam prior to enrolling in MUSC122 - Music Theory I for proper advising in the music theory sequence.

Students pursuing associate degrees, academic certificates, or technical competency areas at BPCC must declare their intent to do so.
