# Principal's Report

# Reconciliation Week

I was very proud to see the activities and learning our teachers and students undertook during Reconciliation Week. Classes celebrated in a variety of ways, sharing different cultures, making decorated artefacts and many students joining in designing and painting a new mural. ### **Student Free Day**

All staff were able to participate last Friday in professional learning at Laura Sports Centre or Laura Primary School with our local Upper Mid North Partnership sites.

Finance officers spent time with Rob Larrson, working on the finance package. They were given new information, talked about how to read the reports generated and other useful tips.

Student Support Officers (SSOs) had a day titled "Engaging Challenging Students" - with workshops on: Speech and Language development and working with Speech Pathologists, Using iPads to enhance learning, Managing Difficult behaviours with individuals and small groups and Working with children with Aspergers. These sessions were presented by Regional Office staff Alyce Ridgeway, Paul McLeod, Tania Cagney, Matt Wilton and Tanya Davidson.

The last session was presented by our Education Officer, Terry Sizer, and was about Application Writing which was very timely, given the way in which support staff will be employed.

There was also a training which focussed on Pre School and Kindy which was held at the Laura Kindy.

Our teachers had the opportunity to work with Rosie Kerin on "Your Place: Designing a local curriculum", she engaged us with using our local communities and places to develop a unit of work which has significance for our students. This work was linked to General Capabilities and Cross curriculum priorities of the Australian Curriculum. We were able to share how we have connected learning with our local community with our work with the RSL on Anzac Day.

The day was of great benefit to all of our groups within the school and relationships have been formed with staff from other sites within our Partnership. This will be important as we grow and develop our Partnership model to improve outcomes for students and communities.


