Fee Payments

You may pay school fees by cash or cheque (payable to Branton School) on the dates given above or you may **pay on-line (new for 2012-13)**. You will need to set up an account and you will need to enter the same email address that we have for you in our student records database. The website says that on-line payments will be available on September 15th but I hope to have all fees entered for all grades and ready to go by Thursday September 6th. If you want to purchase a gym strip on-line for a grade 8 or 9 student, please email me and ask me to assign that fee to your child's account.

Waiver of Fees

You may apply to have the following fees waived: Instructional Supplies and Materials Fee (ISM), Musical Instrument Registration (Band) and Bussing or Transportation Fee (Tran).

Please submit your application as soon as possible. Applicants are responsible for all fees incurred prior to approval of the waiver (amount waived only applies from approval date forward – for example; fees are owing for 3 months if waiver is approved in December).
