

Upstairs Front: 3 Form Canopy

3-Form is a material made from recycled plastic. The plastic is formed into useful and artistic items in the building, such as a canopy and this sign. It is as peaceful as a butterfly because it is always communicating.

3 Form is part of the LEED features of Materials Selection. It is made in Utah and is from recycled materials, both of which help the environment.

Teachers can help students understand how exciting this material is. Students can maintain it by being respectful of the signs and other 3-form art both inside and outside the building.

3-Form is used for the outside canopy in front of the building. It is also used for the divider in the commons area and for this sign and others you see in the building.

People can recycle plastic which is what 3-form is made from. They can also look for ways to reuse old items in a new or artistic way.
