



## **Pink Ribbon Tea Fundraising Tips**

## Some fun and easy tips to help make your tea a success!

- 1. If you don't know where you're going, how will you know when you get there? Set a **fundraising goal** and be prepared to share it with everyone.
- 2. Use a goal chart (thermometers are popular) to check and display your progress.
- 3. Wear a pink ribbon pin; it's a great conversation starter.
- 4. Be prepared with a compelling story, and if you are comfortable, tell your personal story of how you are affected by breast cancer or how breast cancer has affected your family or friends.
- 5. If something has worked in the past, let it work for you again.
- 6. Be **optimistic!** Excitement is highly contagious and it's important for potential donors to know and feel how enthusiastic you are about supporting the cause.

## Tips to reach your fundraising goal:

- 1. Sell tickets to your tea or ask each guest for a minimum donation to attend.
- 2. Use the online fundraising page to promote your tea and collect donations.
- 3. Ask your guests to bring delicious baked goods to your tea....and auction off the goodies to the highest bidder!
- 4. Hold a baking class as part of your tea and ask for a donation to attend.
- 5. Ask your company for a corporate match or gift to complement your fundraising efforts.
- 6. Create floral centerpieces for your tea and raffle them off at the end of your tea.
- 7. Hold a silent auction. Have guests donate bought or homemade items for people to bid on and donate the proceeds.
- 8. Hold a 50/50 draw at your tea the winner takes half the pot, and the remainder is donated\*.
- 9. Do you have a friend with a special talent? Do you know a tea leaf reader, sketch artist, mobile massage therapist? Ask if they would reduce the cost or donate their time at your tea and then, ask your guests to make a donation to take part.
