The expectations for behavior that are listed below are consistent with those that exist when a student is in class or at a school activity. Individuals who are unable, or unwilling, to behave within these expectations are advised not to attend in the dance. Students on the No Activities List are not allowed to attend the dance.

WARNING: STROBE LIGHTS MAY BE USED THROUGHOUT THE EVENING

- You must provide a current school ID at time of ticket purchase. Sales of tickets are final—no refunds will be given. **Students are required to show a school ID to enter the dance.**
- No students will be admitted into the dance after 10:00 p.m. (8:30 for the Senior Ball, as a meal is served).
- Once you have entered the dance, if you decide to leave or have been *asked to leave*, you will **not be allowed** to re-enter, and no refund for admission will be given.
- No backpacks or bags will be allowed. Students are subject to search by security at the door.
- All students must be willing to submit to a search for alcohol, drugs, or tobacco products should administration think necessary.
- If a student becomes involved in one the following situations, disciplinary consequences will be administered according to the California Education Code and parents will be notified:
 - Harassing behaviors directed at any student, teacher, parent, or any other person(s)
 - Fighting, or the physical assault of another person(s)
 - Possession, use, or sale of weapons, drugs, or alcohol
 - Students who appear to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be tested, and if under the influence, will be suspended from school. (Note: police will be notified.)
 - Student wearing clothing that is in violation of the school dress code policy
 - Sexually explicit dancing; and exhibitionism, including overt and explicit sexual behavior.

Dance Dress Code

Dress Code:

Davis Joint Unified School District regulations expect student dress and grooming to be appropriate for a positive educational environment. Dress and personal hygiene that could be considered distracting, derogatory, offensive, intimidating, or interfering with the educational process, is prohibited. If a student is found in violation of the dance dress code, they will not be allowed into the dance until the student has changed into suitable attire.

Apparel should:

- Cover front and back, top and bottom: no low cut necklines, strapless, backless, bikini, tube, spaghetti straps, halter or single strap shirts, no loose arm-hole shirts/tanks, etc. No undergarments showing (i.e. underwear, bras, bra straps, thongs). No exposed midriff. Skirts and shorts should be modest and cover the student's bottom.
- Be free of any image or depiction of drugs, alcohol, sex, tobacco, and/or anything illegal.
- Be free of any image or depiction associated or affiliated with gang activity.
- Be safe in, and not distracting to, the environment.
- Because our dances are held on our basketball courts, shoes must be soft-soled. No hard-soled shoes will be allowed (Shoes should not "clack" on a hard surface).

Dress/Physical Appearance

Students in violation may be asked to make corrections such as the following:

- Turn shirt inside out
- Put on a sweater/coat
- Cover up exposed area
- Call home for a change of clothes

Junior Prom and Senior Ball Dress Code

The Junior Prom and Senior Ball are formal dances. Please dress appropriately. Keep in mind that all attire-related concerns will be addressed by administration accordingly. Sexually explicit dancing and exhibitionism—including overt and explicit sexual behavior—may result in your being asked to leave the dance.

- Strapless and Spaghetti straps are allowed.
- Clothing must cover front and back, top and bottom—No plunging necklines, bare midriffs, or see-through garments to exposed skin.
- Shirts must remain on.
- Shorts and skirts can be no shorter than fingertip length (subject to administrator's discretion)
- All undergarments must be covered at all times.
- No images or depictions of drugs, alcohol, sex, tobacco, and/or illegal activity.

Dancing Guidelines

- No straddling legs.
- No overt/prolonged PDA.
- Must keep at least one foot on floor at all times.
- No explicitly sexual behavior.

Please note that for the Senior Ball, no DJUSD student is permitted to have a previous/current room reservation to use the hotel rooms at the Sheraton Hotel or surrounding hotels (This expectation is also for your guest). If a student happens to occupy a room at the Sheraton Hotel, all damage caused to any material/item, room, or person will be directly the legal responsibility of the occupant (i.e. Student) to reimburse the hotel, (per Sheraton Hotel Management). The use of a hotel room is considered leaving the event, and students will not be allowed re-entry to the dance.
