 Review of the latest FTC guide ".com Disclosures: How to Make Effective Disclosures in Digital Advertising," updated March, 2013

 Recent FTC enforcement actions (March, 2012 / December 2012 / September 2013 / January 2014) – including 'drip pricing' warnings and implications for dealers The FTC has indicated that deceptive dealer ads are a "significant problem" and this is a "priority area."

 Important changes to the Telephone Consumer Protection Act (TCPA) – significant changes to prior consent requirements when calling or texting cell phones—even informational messages.

The FTC has stated that marketing and PR groups could also be liable – forward this to vendors.
