3. DESCRIPTION:

a. Purpose of grant and impact to student body as a whole:

The purpose of this STEP Technology Fee Application is to have two SMART Classrooms installed for the Communication department in rooms B140 and B250. These will be of the new SMART Classroom standard using all-in-one SMART Technologies, Inc. LCD projector and whiteboard as specified through Information Networks using the vendor Detel.

Impact to student body as a whole:

SMART classroom equipment is used on a daily basis by faculty for instruction. Most faculty rely on audio / visual presentation equipment to conduct their lectures, from PowerPoint slides, videos, Webpages, and even hand-written notes on document cameras to provide visual (and aural) reinforcement of their lessons. Further, students are often required to give presentations in class, as well. The impact of turning these classrooms into the SMART classroom standard is consistency with other classrooms and improved presentation capability, improving the classroom experience for both faculty and students.

b. Projected lifetime of enhancement:

It is expected that all equipment and software installed would last at least three to five years, and more likely, around five to six years.
