Under Confucianism, the Vietnamese inherited a high respect for learning. Education was essential for admission to the ruling class of scholar officials, known as the Mandarinate. While under French rule the Vietnamese were excluded from the colonial power elite and education was a requisite for employment as a civil servant, and for any other white collar positions. Education continues to be a channel for social mobility both in North and South Vietnam.



Thailand & Education

Thailand has one of the highest levels of functional literacy in Asia. The adult literacy rate in the year 2000 for Thailand was 97% for men and 94% for the women, 96% of their children are enrolled in primary school education, and 81% for secondary education.

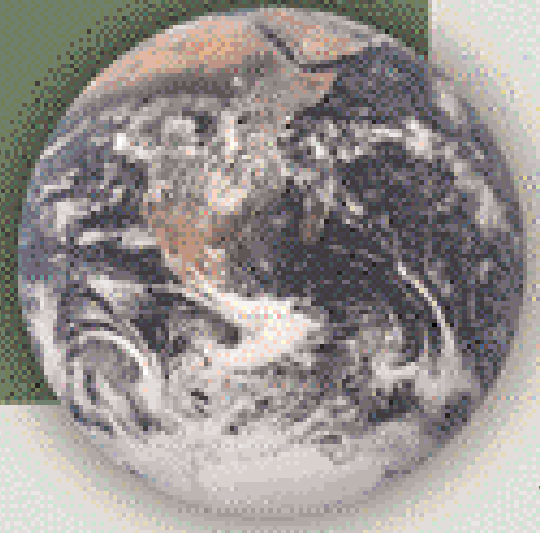

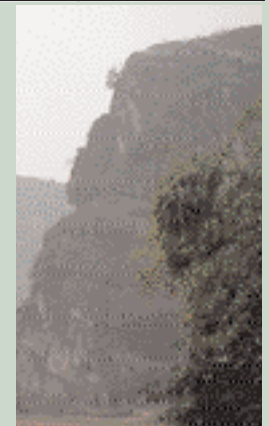

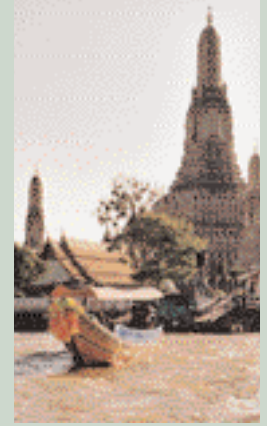

EXHIBIT FEES

In order to attend the CACSU Overseas College Fairs in Vietnam and Thailand, you must return the Exhibit Registration Form. To attend the fair, it is not necessary to be a member of our organization, but we encourage all that attend to become a member of our organization.

Exhibitors may attend one of the two fairs or both of the fairs. If attending both of the College Fairs, you must register with the appropriate exhibit booth rates.

No fees will be assessed for guest registration. Guest registrants includes: spouses, companions, and children of registrants. Registered participants and guest registrants may visit the exhibit hall and attend the Welcome Reception.

EARLY REGISTRATION

The early registration application will receive a \$50.00 discount on college fair registration fees.

STANDARD REGISTRATION

Standard registration must have all necessary forms completed and submitted with payment via check, money order, cashier's check or credit card.

PAYMENT

The Exhibit Registration and Sightseeing Tour Forms must be accompanied by check, money order, credit card or cashier's check. One payment method can be submitted for both the exhibit registration and sightseeing tour. Forms received without payment will not be processed. All payments must be made in U.S. currency. CONFIRMATIONS

College Fair confirmations will be sent out via e-mail to the registrant within 72 hours of receipt of payment and material.

EXHIBIT SPACE CONTRACT

CASCU College Fair Exhibit Hall Regulations and Information

The Consortium of American Schools, Colleges and Universities (CASCU) College Fair Information Sheet, Registration, and Regulations and Information Form must be signed and dated by the Institution that will be an Exhibitor at the CASCU College Fair in Vietnam and or Thailand. Full payment must accompany these documents.

FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.

CASCU TABLE ASSIGNMENT: CASCU's Exhibitor will be granted on a random basis by the CASCU offices. Upon acceptance, copies of these documents will be returned to the Exhibitor/Institution. CASCU reserves the right to assign table space in order to avoid conflict, as it deems appropriate.

BOOTH: Each booth will contain a 10x10 table and 2 chairs. You are also welcome to bring your own materials that you might need to display your booth items.

ALL ACTIVITY MUST BE LIMITED TO THE TABLE ASSIGNED. EXHIBITORS FAILING TO ADHERE WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE CASCU COLLEGE FAIR EXHIBIT AREA/DESIGNATED LOCATION.

INSTALLATION/DISMANTLING: Set-up for the CASCU and Exhibitors' Area will take place in Vietnam and Thailand on Friday, between 12:00 PM and 4:00PM ONLY! The Hours of Operation for the College Fair Exhibit Area are Saturday, 9:00 AM - 7:00 PM

MATERIAL HANDLING: All Exhibitors will be responsible for handling their own materials. In addition, please store unused items in exhibitor area underneath exhibitor table.

STORAGE OF PACKING BOXES AND CRATES: Exhibitors are able to store empty packing boxes or crates in booths underneath the exhibitor tables during the CASCU.

LIABILITY AND INSURANCE: The Exhibitor assumes the entire responsibility and hereby agrees to protect, indemnify, defend and save CASCU Exhibitors' Pavilion, CASCU, and its employees and agents harmless against all claims, losses and damages to persons or property, governmental charges or fines and attorney fees arising out of or caused by the Exhibitor's installation, removal, maintenance, occupancy or use of the exhibition premises or part thereof excluding such liability, as may be caused by the sole negligence of the Hotel Facility, or its employees and agents or assigns. In addition, the Exhibitor acknowledges that neither CASCU nor the Hotel selected maintain insurance covering the Exhibitor's property and that it is the sole responsibility of the Exhibitor to obtain business interruption and property damage insurance covering such losses by the Exhibitor.

EXHIBITORS ARE ADVISED TO CARRY INSURANCE AGAINST DAMAGE, LOSS, FIRE AND THEFT, BUT IT IS NOT REQUIRED.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT: It is expressly agreed and understood between the Exhibitors and CASCU that CASCU shall be under no liability for loss of, or damage to goods and property of educational institution. Nor shall CASCU be held liable to personal injuries to Exhibitor's or their agents. Each Exhibitor, upon signing this agreement, expressly releases CASCU from and agrees to hold CASCU harmless from all such claims. The Hold Harmless Clause includes and indemnifies CASCU against any claims arising out of the negligent acts or omissions of Exhibitor in the use of the table space. The Exhibitor further warrants to obey all rules, regulations, and laws of the facilities as they may affect or apply to the CASCU College Fair.

SECURITY: Exhibitors should take precautionary measures of their own such as the securing of small or easily portable articles of value, and the removal of them to a place of safe keeping after exhibit hours.

FIRE PREVENTION: No combustible decoration, such as crepe paper, cardboard, or corrugated paper shall be used at any time. All packing containers, excelsior, wrapping paper, which must be flame proof are to be removed from the floor and must be stored under tables or behind displays. All display material must meet state and local codes for flame proof. All materials and fluids which are flammable are to be kept in safety containers. Open flame, butane gas, oxygen tanks, etc., are not permitted.

CANCELLATION OR POSTPONEMENT OF EXHIBITION: In the event that the Exhibition is postponed due to any occurrence not occasioned by the conduct of CASCU or the Exhibitor, whether such occurrence by an Act of God or the common enemy or the result of war, riot, civil commotion, sovereign conduct, or the act of any person or persons not party or privy to this agreement, then the performance of the parties under this Agreement shall be excused for such period of time as is reasonably necessary after such occurrence to remedy the effects thereof and in any event for the duration of such post-

ponement in the event that such occurrence results in cancellation of the Exhibition, the obligations of the parties under the Agreement shall be automatically terminated and all fees made under this Agreement shall be refunded to Exhibitor, less pro rata share of expenses actually incurred by CASCU in connection with the exhibition.

USE OF SPACE: The institution's display must be contained completely within the specified boundaries of the table space in compliance with the following provisions, and no portion of the display may extend into the aisle nor into any adjoining table or other area outside the perimeters of the table. The display must provide sufficient standing or seating area within said perimeters to accommodate the booth attendants as well as any anticipated stationary audiences which the display is designed to attract. The Exhibitor may not use any portion of the aisles, entrances, or other common traffic-ways of the exhibit hall for the conduct or solicitation of business and enrollment, for the promotion of products or services, or for the distribution of literature, materials or souvenirs. Only approved Exhibitors may participate in the CASCU College Fair Exhibit area. The leasing of space by an Exhibitor to another Exhibitor is prohibited and shall result in expulsion from the college fair area and/or the termination of the Agreement.

CARE OF BUILDING AND EQUIPMENT: Exhibitors and their agents shall not injure or deface the walls of the building, or the tables. Exhibitors are forbidden to drive tacks, nails, or screws into the walls, floors, columns or other parts of the building or furniture. Distribution of gummed stickers or labels is strictly prohibited. The Exhibitor and its agent must comply with the rules and regulations of the Hotel facilities.

SEVERABILITY AND WAIVER: No waiver of any provisions of this contract shall be valid unless in writing and signed by the party against whom enforcement is sought. If any portion of this contract is determinant to be unenforceable or invalid, such determination shall not be deemed to affect the enforceability or validity of the remainder of the contract. Acceptance of the contract by CASCU shall in no way be construed as an endorsement by CASCU of either an Institution/Exhibitor or its products or services. CASCU reserves the right to determine eligibility of Exhibitors for the College Fair in Vietnam and/or Thailand. CASCU reserves the right to modify College Fair hours, make adjustments in booth assignments, size, and equipment, as deemed necessary to meet college fair scheduling and programming needs.

RESTRICTIONS IN OPERATION AND EXHIBITS: The Exhibitor agrees to comply strictly with the applicable terms and conditions contained in the agreement between the Hotel(s) and CASCU regarding the exhibition premises. CASCU reserves the right to restrict exhibits, which because of noise, method of operation, materials, or any other reason become objectionable, and also, to prohibit or evict any exhibit, which in the opinion of show management, may detract from the general character of the exhibit as a whole. This reservation includes persons, things, conduct, printed matter, or anything of a character which CASCU determines is objectionable to the exhibition or does not conform to CASCU standards. In the event of such restriction or eviction, CASCU is not liable for any refund or other exhibit expenses.

CASCU RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CHARGE COLLEGE FAIR ENTRANCE FEES AT ITS DISCRETION.

DISCLAIMER: The Consortium of American Schools, Colleges, and Universities (CASCU) does not guarantee student enrollment for any institution or CASCU member. The CASCU College Fair is an opportunity for U.S. educational institutions to be exposed to international students that reside in Vietnam and Thailand. These conditions may not be changed, altered, modified or waived except in writing signed by an authorized representative expressly authorized to do so by us. Our failure to insist at any time upon any rights, limitations, remedies, or conditions hereunder shall not be deemed a waiver thereof or nor bar a subsequent assertion thereof. 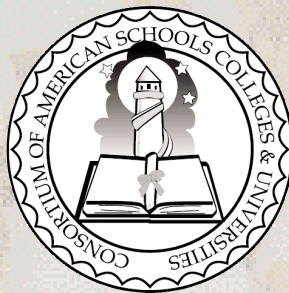
