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Mentoring Program

The goal of the GISCI mentoring program is to link students up with GISPs for a 6-month mentoring relationship. A successful mentoring relationship will result in one contribution point being awarded to the GISP. All GISPs are eligible to become mentors. GISPs are added to the database of mentors. Adding your name to the database does not guarantee you will be a mentor. It means you are eligible to be a mentor. How mentoring works:

- 1. A student or young professional visits the GISCI website.
- 2. They search the manifest of GISPs by "Mentor" which will list all the potential mentors in the program.
- 3. The student completes a web form that asks the name of the mentor(s) they are interested in working with.
- 4. GISCI sends the student's contact information to the potential mentor.
- 5. The mentor indicates his/her willingness or ability to help.
- 6. After 6-months, the mentor and mentored evaluate the mentoring relationship and GISCI awards one contribution point based on a positive evaluation.

If a mentor is not able to assist at the time, GISCI will look to link the student up with a suitable replacement. If your application is not accepted, you are not eligible to mentor.
