On November 19, 2013 a new Epic feature titled Care Everywhere will be available.

Care Everywhere gives clinicians the ability to view patient information from outside Epic organizations that are currently using Epic Care Everywhere. Care Everywhere information is available as a textual report and kept separate from the patient's local chart. Meaningful Use Stage 2 Transitions of Care measure P224 requires the use of Care Everywhere framework.

Care Everywhere outside record information will provide access to clinical summaries, encounter summaries, and test results.

Requests for outside records may be performed by registration or office staff during the check-in process, as well as clinicians at the point of care within the visit navigator.

Some organizations may request that the patient provide authorization. If it is required, then an Authorization form will need to be printed, signed by the patient and scanned into *one*Chart.
