	2. Verify official transcripts, from high school (or GED) and all colleges previously attended, have been received and are in your Division of Health Sciences folder.

	5. NOTE: It is the student's responsibility to follow up with Student Records for transfer of credits.
	6. Must be eligible to take BIO 210 prior to entry into the program.
	7. Biophysical science course credits and mathematics course credits must be earned within five years of admissions to any Health Sciences program.

Generic applicants must meet one of the following criteria:</p> <p>Score at least a 73 (adjusted individual total score) on the TEAS IV or at least a 63 (adjusted individual total score) on the TEAS V and:</p> <p>a. Minimum TCL GPA of 2.5, GPA of 2.5 from last college attended if no TCL GPA, or</p> <p>b. Minimum high school GPA of 2.5 for students graduating within 12 months of application date</p> <p>OR</p> <p>c. Score at least a 67 (adjusted individual total score) on the TEAS IV or at least a 57 (adjusted individual total score) on the TEAS V and complete the following courses: BIO 210, BIO 211, PSY 201, PSY 203, MAT120 , and ENG 101 with a total TCL GPA ≥ 2.75 .</p> <p>The TEAS test may only be taken twice within a 12 month period from date of first test. Applicants with two or more failures (D, F, WF) in required non-Nursing courses (BIO 210, BIO 211, BIO 225, ENG 101, ENG 102, MAT 120, PSY 201, or PSY 203) within the last five years must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Score at least 73 (adjusted individual total score) on the TEAS IV or at least a 63 (adjusted individual total score) on the TEAS V b. Complete all required non-nursing courses in the program of study (BIO 210, BIO 211, BIO 225, ENG 101, ENG 102, MAT 120, PSY 201, & PSY 203) with a total TCL GPA ≥ 2.75. Math and biology courses must have been completed within the last five years. <p>OR</p> <p>Applicants with two or more failures (D, F, WF) in Nursing courses have one opportunity for admission. Applicant must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> c. Score greater than 80 (adjusted individual total score) on the TEAS IV or greater than 70 (adjusted individual total score) on the TEAS V d. Complete all non-nursing courses in the program of study (BIO 210, BIO 211, BIO 225, ENG 101, ENG 102, MAT 120, PSY 201, and PSY 203) with a GPA ≥ 2.75. Math courses must be completed within the last five years. Biology courses must be completed within 18 months from the date of application. e. Wait a minimum of two academic years from time of second failure to apply.
	<p>10. I understand that if accepted into the program:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. I must maintain a TCL GPA of at least 2.5 to enter the program. b. I must have access to a computer and internet as all nursing courses have an online component. c. I must be able to attend clinical rotation at sites within a 60 mile radius of the Beaufort or New River campus. d. I will be required to attend Nursing classes at the Beaufort campus as not all Nursing classes are offered at the New River campus. e. I must attend a mandatory orientation, in May for fall entry students and November for spring entry students. f. I must meet with Dean Sapp if questionable charges are on my background check. g. I will be required to submit a \$100 nonrefundable fee to secure my spot.
