PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

The goods and services shown in this booklet are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff, and Overhead

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; coordination with those providing other services of the funeral, e.g. cemetery, crematory, vault companies and others as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as sheltering of remains, professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, parking lot and grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, recordkeeping, and secretarial and administrative expenses. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving of remains.)

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are unfinished wood boxes and fiberboard boxes.

The biggest challenge is to find a cemetery in our area that will allow a green burial. Please ask us for any additional information, and as the process continues, we will offer these special services and merchandise to our families that request it.

Cremation Authorization

A cremation authorization will need to be signed by family members FOLLOWING the death of an individual. All (or a majority) of individuals in a next-of-kin class must sign the authorization. If a person does not live locally, or will not be attending the arrangement conference, the family must provide a fax number that can be used to process the cremation authorization for that individual's signature. Families may go to www.lakeshorememorial.com to obtain a PDF cremation authorization form that may be faxed to our office.



Michigan law states that the right to control final disposition belongs to family members in the following order:

Spouse...Adult children (over 18 years old)...Adult grandchildren...Adult great-grandchildren...Parents... Brothers and sisters...Nieces and Nephews...Grandparents...Aunts and Uncles...Cousins

The final disposition decisions may be made by a majority of the individuals in a next-of-kin-class (50% + 1). If a family member cannot be located by reasonable efforts (last known address, phone number or email) by family members or personal representatives, the disposition may continue as long as there is a majority in the same degree of kinship.

If the majority decision does not yield a satisfactory result, a family member may petition the Probate Court for a possible resolution.



Payment terms are cash, check, credit card or insurance assignment at the time of arrangements. Approved financing is available through American General Financial Services.
