A. Purpose

As we work alongside missionaries Rick and Jan Cunningham, our purpose will be four-fold:

- 1. To launch Character Connex within the country by training local leaders to present the program.
- 2. To present Character Connex school assemblies in public schools in Romania alongside local teams.
- 3. To be involved with and assist Rick and Jan with outreaches and with their day-to-day ministry.
- 4. To conduct children's ministry training for the nationals.

• Bucharest, Romania, and neighboring villages and cities.

E. Financial Information

1. Cost: \$3250

- This includes airfare from an East coast gateway city (ex. New York, Detriot, Minneapolis, Boston), lodging, transportation, meals, and other expenses.
- You will be responsible for your airfare from your home city to our gateway city. You can receive World Missions credit for the airfare costs from your home city to our gateway city by filling out the "Team Expense Report Form" included in this packet. Once you have filled out this form, please send it back to our office.



 Included in the travel expense are funds to help supply Romania with 3 full Character Connex kits and other supplies. There is also a portion for administration of the trip, and the national Character Connex office.

2. BGMC Credit

- You will receive full BGMC credit for the entire \$3250 trip cost.
- To receive BGMC credit for monies given to this project, please use the attached Target Form whenever you send in a check for the project.
- If the form is not enclosed with each check that you send in, we cannot guarantee that funds will be put in the right account.

3. Online payments and contributions

- Trip payments and contributions can be made by credit card online at <u>www.characterconnex.org</u>. The target form is not needed if contributions are made online. All online contributions will receive BGMC giving credit.
- Team members can direct people who wish to contribute to their trip to our website. These donations may be made by credit card. For tracking purposes, it is vital that people who contribute make note of the team member whom they are contributing to.

4. Extra offerings

• If your church would like to take offerings above and beyond the \$3250 for this project, they may. These offerings will also receive BGMC giving credit and can be designated for either Character Connex or Romania Children's Ministry.

5. Financial Timeline

- Meeting these deadlines is very important. We will not purchase airfare for any team member unless the deadlines have been met and there are funds in the team member's account. If we don't meet our deadlines, we could miss out.
 November 1, 2007: \$300 (non-refundable deposit due from each team member) Janaury 15, 2008: \$1500 due
 February 15, 2008: \$1450 due
- Please limit the number of checks that you send in to our office to 2 checks a month. This will help us in efficiently processing your checks and will ensure that we get your contributions properly credited to you account.



6. Cancellation Policy

- We ask that you prayerfully consider this trip before you sign up. When you sign up and take a spot on the team, we will be counting on you to be a part of the team. Last-minute cancellations will severely hurt this missions trip. If there is any possibility that you would have to cancel, we ask that you let us know when you sign up so that we can make the appropriate pre-planning decisions. We do understand that last-minute emergencies come up. If a true last-minute emergency comes up, we have instituted the following cancellation policy.
- The \$300.00 deposit is non-refundable.
- After December 1: We will refund the money that has been given to the project minus the cos
 of the airline ticket, the deposit, and an administrative fee of \$500.00 to cover other costs
 that have been incurred for the trip.
- After January 1: There will be no refunds. Any money left over due to cancellations will be used to cover the cost of airline tickets that have already been purchased and other travel costs that have been incurred.
- **Misconduct:** If a team member is sent home from this missions trip because of misconduct or any other reason, the team member will be responsible to make arrangements to get home. This includes paying change fees for airline ticket as well as any other costs incurred. No refunds will be given to team members who are dismissed because of misconduct.
- If this trip is cancelled for reasons beyond our control: We will give you a refund minus the cost of the airfare. You will be given your ticket so that you can use it on another trip.

E. Itinerary

• We will be releasing an itinerary for this trip once we have purchased airline tickets and have a firm time and city that we will be flying out of.

G. Character Connex Experience

- **Training:** If you have not been through one of our Character Connex trainings, we highly recommend that you attend one if possible. For a listing of training events, please go to the web site at <u>www.characterconnex.org</u>. There will be no charge for you to attend a training. (If you are not able to attend a training event or be trained before we leave, you are still eligible to participate in this trip. Please let us know, though. We will work out a way to get you trained.)
- **Experience:** We suggest that team members participate or lead at least one school assembly in their home town, if possible, before the trip. (Once again, this is not a requirement, only a request.)

H. General Trip Information

- 1. Passport
 - Each team member must have a valid and current passport.
 - If you do not have a passport, please apply for one immediately. Passports can take more than 6-8 weeks to process.
 - Please mail a copy of your passport along with your application for this trip.
 - We also recommend bringing a copy of your passport on this trip.

2. Currency

• The official currency of Romania is Lei. We recommend that team members bring their personal money in USA dollars to exchange in Bucharest for the trip. To get the best exchange rate bring \$20, \$50, or \$100 dollar bills.

3. Security

• Romania is very safe. In twelve years of having teams come to Romania, our missionaries have never had any security issues. Team members are encouraged to always protect their personal effects and passports.

4. Medical

 No shots are required to enter the country. We do recommend that you get the advice of your doctor as far as the shots he or she may feel are necessary. While in Romania, there are good hospitals available that are very reasonable compared to the hospitals in the states. Please make sure your tetanus shot is up to date.



5. Packing

- Please plan on packing light for this trip. We will be bringing foot lockers in addition to our luggage. These containers will be filled with Character Connex props, and also general children's ministry supplies. As the trip gets closer, we will fill you in on packing requirements.
- Children's Ministry Supplies to Bring: Our missionary would like to bring and give out markers and/or pencils to each child who attends the assemblies. They also need each team member to bring several bags of hard candy and suckers.
- **Airline Packing Requirements:** We will be forwarding this information to you once we have purchased the airline tickets for this trip.
- At the airport: Our team will arrive at the airport at least three hours before check-in. Do not bring meat or dairy products with you. We also recommend attaching a Character Connex Luggage tag to each of your bags (these are provided). This will help the team find all of our bags on the carousel. You will be responsible to retrieve your own bags at the airport. This will help avoid any problems with lost bags. When we arrive in Uruguay we will go through immigration, and customs. A key point to passing these areas smoothly is to declare everything in your bags as personal.

6. Insurance

 Special overseas insurance is included in the cost of your trip. The insurance is purchased for you and there is no cost to you. The insurance covers accidental death and dismemberment, sickness while on the trip, and accidents on the trip. More information will be emailed to you once you have registered for the trip.

7. Spending money

• We recommend that you bring at least \$100.00 in cash and a major credit card on this trip.

8. Clothing

It will be very cold in Romania during the time that we are there. It may also be muddy in the villages. Even if it's not extremely cold outside, the buildings can be very cold inside. It's best to plan on dressing in layers. Some buildings that do have heat may be very hot. Warm socks, gloves, hats, and a winter coat are highly recommended. We also recommend bringing warm pajamas. More than likely there will be snow on the ground.



• We recommend keeping your clothing and jewelry attire simple. You will also need two Character Connex Ringer T-shirts (we supply these for you). For Character Connex assemblies, our official dress will be the Character Connex polo or ringer, and khakis.

9. Culture and Ministry Information

A. Culture

- Romania is an Orthodox country. However, there are areas near the Black Sea with large Turkish Muslim communities. We will be going to one city in this area. The other towns we will visit will be Romanian and/or Gypsy near the Serbian border. These cities will be about eight hours from Bucharest (the city of Arad and surrounding villages).
- Romanians love Americans. They are very helpful. Many of the young people speak English, but the children do not. All of our ministry will be in Romanian.
- Romania was a Communist country. They had a dictator who did much to destroy both the country and its culture. We will be visiting a palace built by the dictator in Bucharest. It is the world's second largest building. It now houses the Romanian parliament. Romania is now a very safe and stable democracy which just joined the European Union last January. We will be doing sightseeing in Bucharest and the surrounding areas.
- Because the church was not allowed to teach children about God during Communism years, the church has not done very much in terms of child evangelism. Many churches did not believe that children under 16 could be saved. Some churches did not encourage families with younger children to bring their children to church.
- Large families with six to ten children are still very common. Smaller churches often do not have room for the children. As a result, there is very little training, resources, or outreach to children that takes place in Romania.

B. Ministry

- Our team will be doing assemblies in the Bucharest area. We will be ministering in International Schools, Reformatory schools, and public Romanian schools. We will also be training Save Romania's Children volunteers to do Character Connex after we leave.
- We will then be going to a city near the Black Sea to do a school-wide assembly. The children will be a mix of Romanian children, Gypsy children, and Turkish children (Orthodox and Muslim backgrounds).
- The third area of ministry will be in Arad. Arad is an eight- to nine-hour drive from Bucharest. In Arad we will be dividing up and visiting both city and village schools. On Sunday we will be ministering in churches. We also hope to do evening outreaches in several places.



- We will be breaking up into teams with team leaders. Each team will be given a topic to prepare for. We will be using what the team prepares in outreaches that our missionary has put together. Our missionary is asking us to come prepared with illusions, Bible stories, and memory verse activities. We will also be learning drama skits and puppet skits once we get to Romania.
- In the outreaches, we will be building upon what we have taught in the school assemblies during the day.

C. Information about who we will be working with

- The group will be working with the Save Romania's Children team. The team will be lead by Jan Cunningham and Tony and Pam Bolyard (children's pastors in Florida for nine years prior to coming to Romania.
- Save Romania's Children exists to train and mentor young Romanians and churches to work with children. SRC helps train anyone involved in any kind of children's ministry church workers, school teachers, orphanage workers, camp staffs. SRC also provides materials, training seminars, outreaches, camps, and school assemblies. Presently, SRC sends out lessons and materials to over 400 children's workers in Romania every month via the Internet. You can find out more information about SRC at www.saveromaniaschildren.com.

10. Sightseeing Opportunities

- Our travel will take us through some of the country's most beautiful mountain areas. Some of the areas will be in the Transylvanian Alps.
- Romania has beautiful glass, china, and pottery work. We will take some time off to sightsee and shop. The food is great.
- Be ready to work hard, but have a good time also.
