Agreement of Arnold & Porter, LLP ("A&P"), Orrick, Herrington & Sutcliffe, LLP

("Orrick") and Richards Layton & Finger ("RLF"); to provide legal services to the Receiver.

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2. A&P has submitted itemized statements for services rendered related to MIC by members of A&P and for reimbursable costs incurred in connection with those services pursuant to the orders referenced above for the time periods of September 2012 through The statements have been approved by the Receiver of the Arizona October 2012. Department of Insurance and the total amount billed for this period by A&P under these statements is Nine Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand, Nine Hundred Eighty-Six and 38/100 dollars. The fees presented herein for A&P are primarily related to two main areas: (1) the dispute between the Receiver and The PMI Group, Inc. ("TPG"), MIC's parent in bankruptcy, and the Unsecured Creditors Committee ("UCC") in that bankruptcy proceeding (denominated below as "PMI Group"); and (2) work with respect to the efforts by the Receiver to sell MIC assets (denominated below as "General Corp."). Those fees are per month as follows:

3. Orrick has submitted itemized statements for services rendered related to MIC by members of Orrick and for reimbursable costs incurred in connection with those services pursuant to the orders referenced above for the time period of October 2012 through November 2012. The statements for this period have been approved by the Receiver of the Arizona Department of Insurance. The amount billed by Orrick for October 2012 is \$108,453.01 and the amount billed for November 2012 is \$104,295.72. The total amount

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billed for October 2012 through November 2012 as reflected on the statements is Two Hundred Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-Eight and 73/100 (\$212,748.73) dollars. The fees presented herein for Orrick relate primarily to tax issues, mostly in the dispute between the Receiver and TPG and the UCC. That dispute, now resolved, was in large measure based on tax issues, which is the primary area of focus for Orrick on behalf of the Receiver.

- 4. RLF has submitted itemized statements for services rendered related to MIC by members of RLF and for reimbursable costs incurred in connection with those services pursuant to the orders referenced above for the time period of September 2012. statement for this period has been approved by the Receiver of the Arizona Department of Insurance. The amount billed by RLF for September 2012 as reflected on the statements is Twenty-Three Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighty-Five and 01/100 (\$23,885.01) dollars. The fees presented herein for RLF relate primarily to bankruptcy issues.
- 5. The press of intense activity in the Receivership, particularly the dispute and settlement thereof with PMI's holding company in bankruptcy and the creditor's committee therein, and reaching the complex transactions set forth in Petitions 24 and 25, has delayed the review and submission of fees, like those presented there. Moreover, those activities just mentioned have generated higher than usual fees, which are reflected in this Petition and others like it.
