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The CBCS Legacy Scholarship is to be awarded to a deserving White Oak High School senior with the following qualifications:

- Must be a graduating senior of White Oak High School
- Maintain at least an un-weighted 2.5 GPA by the expected graduation date
- Must have participated in at least one athletic sport, arts program or one extracurricular activity/organization in their Junior/ Senior year
- Must have attended White Oak High School at least 1 full year
- Must have attained acceptance into a 4- year undergraduate program for the upcoming fall semester by National Collegiate Acceptance Day
