

# Counselor-In-Training

# **Program Description and Application**

Thank you for your interest in becoming a Camp Friedlander Counselor-In-Training (CIT)! The CIT program will provide you with numerous growth and educational opportunities and will serve as the primary training ground for future Camp Friedlander staff members. Please read through this packet of information to better understand the CIT program and for important information about applying.

# **CIT I Program**

Applicants who are 14-years-old by June 1, 2014, if selected, will be a part of the CIT I program. Participants in this program must attend camp for a **minimum of three weeks** over the course of the summer, including mandatory staff training week (June 7 – June 13). Selected weeks do need not be consecutive, but must be full weeks (Sunday – Saturday). CIT I's will spend time in several program areas throughout the camp and assisting with merit badge sessions and programs. This gives them the opportunity to begin working on the skills and knowledge needed as a staff member. They will also get a feel for the program areas that may interest them. Each CIT I will be provided room and board and \$10 in CIT bucks to be spent in the Trading Post for each week they are at camp. Participants will be required to have a full camp staff uniform, but there are no additional costs to parents for this program.

# **CIT II Program**

Applicants who are 15-years-old by June 1, 2013, if selected, will be a part of the CIT II program. While the CIT I program is not mandatory to participate in the CIT II program, preference will be given to those who completed the CIT I program with a positive evaluation. Participants in the CIT II program must attend camp for a **minimum of five weeks** over the course of the summer, including mandatory staff training week (June 7 – June 13). CIT II's will spend the majority of their time in their chosen program area. CIT II's will assist in merit badge instruction for merit badges that they have earned. By the end of the summer, they will have earned all of the merit badges in their chosen program area and will be well-prepared for solo instruction if they should return to camp as a full staff member. Each CIT II will be provided room and board and \$10 in CIT bucks to be spent in the trading post. Participants will be required to have a full camp staff uniform, but there are no additional costs to parents for this program.

# **Responsibilities of CIT's**

Every CIT will have the same rights, privileges, and responsibilities of a full staff member. During staff training week, CIT's will be put in a patrol with other staff members. These patrols will work together on various camp tasks outside of their assigned programs. Responsibilities of all staff members include cleaning tasks, dining hall assignments, skits and songs performances, and other jobs as assigned by their supervisor.
