Dover wins in Hamilton's debut

Jacob Hamilton's debut as Dover's baseball coach on Monday got off to a successful beginning, but also an incomplete one.

Dover knocked off Drummond 6-3 on the road in its fall baseball season opener, but the nightcap was suspended due to weather.

The game was tied 5-5 in the eighth inning when heavy rain brought an abrupt end to the night.

"We're going to finish it sometime, but it might be a while before we do," Hamilton, Dover's first-year

coach, said. Dover is set to host Drummond and Hydro-Eakly in a three-way on Sept. 5.

"We're going to try to get it done then."

As for the game that was completed, the Longhorns rode the arm of Junior Obeso while overcoming five errors.

Obeso struck out 11 and surrendered just one hit in five innings. The lone run he gave up was unearned.

"We had a lot of miscommunication between myself and the team tonight," Hamilton said. "And we've

got a lot of little things to work on, especially the errors.

"But the pitching we got tonight was good enough to win us a lot of games."

Hamilton was also pleased with his team's showing at the plate.

Dover pounded out 11 hits, including three off the bat of Bryan Pacheco. The two-hole hitter also scored three runs.

"We had a lot of confidence at the plate and I liked seeing that," Hamilton said.

Up 4-1, Dover got a pair of insurance runs in the sixth when Al Williams drove in

D'Vante Randle and Rodolfo Ramirez.

Randle had reached on a double, his second of the game. He and Ramirez each drove in a run.

Jesus Gamez and Obeso had a hit each. Gamez drove in two runs with his.

The Longhorns return to action Thursday in the Dover Festival.

As for Monday, Hamilton said he'll take the win.

"The guys played with a lot of heart and were competitive and that's something I like to see," he said.
