## VSC Examiner Course Information

For those wishing to become a Vessel Examiner this three-hour presentation goes through both what it takes to qualify as an examiner and what the process is to perform a vessel safety check. Attendees would do well to preview the USPS website to get an idea of what is involved at: http://www.usps.org/national/vsc/

From the on-line examination to the qualifying of the new examiner, the process will become clear including what information has to be sent back to National.

This course is open to all D12 Squadrons and will be taught by Dick Eckhouse, Bare Cove, Saturday, March 9, from 9-noon at American Legion Hall, 155 Eastern Avenue, Dedham, MA 02026. Directions From the South: Route 128/95 North to exit 15B (Route 1 Dedham exit). From the North: Route 128/95 South to exit 15B (Route 1 Dedham exit).

Travel on Route 1 about 1.3 miles and take right at light just before Staples onto Eastern Ave. The American Legion is about .3 miles on the right just before you go up a hill. (If you get to a 4-way stop at the top of the hill you have gone too far). The American Legion has an Army tank out front. Enter through front door.
