TECHNICAL ANNOUNCEMENT

1. GENERAL

The 2013 U.S. Figure Skating qualifying competition season consists of a total of 13 events. These include 12 qualifying events (nine regional championships, three sectional championships), and the 2013 U.S. Figure Skating Championships (juvenile, intermediate, novice, junior and senior). All 13 events are sanctioned by U.S. Figure Skating and conducted according to the most current U.S. Figure Skating rulebook, 2013 edition, with changes and clarifications as posted on the U.S. Figure Skating web site and this announcement. Compliance with these rules as updated or amended is the responsibility of the participants. U.S. Figure Skating reserves the right to incorporate revisions to the international judging system (IJS) made by the ISU for junior and senior events and by U.S. Figure Skating to novice events and below.

The qualifying and national championship competitions are only open to competitors who (1) Are current members of U.S. Figure Skating (2) Meet the eligibility requirements according to U.S. Figure Skating Rule 2211 (3) Meet all age and test requirements pertaining to the event to be entered and (4) Meet the citizen and residency requirements as stated in Rules 2230-2243 and ICR 6.09 of the U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook. Please note amendments have been made to the requirements for returning U.S. skaters as well as non-U.S. skaters wishing to compete. Consult the rulebook to ensure you complete the necessary requirements.

Important Notice for All Coaches

To coach at a U.S. Figure Skating qualifying level competition, a professional coach or choreographer must be:

- Declared by a skater in the registration process with U.S. Figure Skating
- Listed as Coaches Education Requirement (CER) Category A compliant for 2012-2013
- Current with Coach Registration (requires annual fee and background check)
- A current member in good standing with U.S. Figure Skating
- A current member in good standing with the PSA

Each local organizing committee (LOC) will be provided with a list of coaches who are cleared for a credential at the competition. Coaches will need to check in at the event registration desk and show a government issued photo I.D. to receive a credential. Coaches who are NOT on the list will need to show proof of membership in both U.S. Figure Skating and the PSA, a Coaches Registration card, proof of Category A compliance in CER, and a photo I.D. at check in. **If a coach cannot provide a photo I.D. and is not on the list or cannot produce the necessary documents, he or she will not be allowed a credential – no exceptions. We strongly urge all coaches to have their cards with them.**

Important Notice for All Pairs and Dance Teams

All pairs and dance teams will begin their qualifying season at their respective sectional championships (unless they have been notified of a bye advancing them directly to the U.S. Championships). These events are no longer offered at the regional championships.

2. REGISTRATION

A. METHOD

Online Electronic Registration (Required)

Online registration is the ONLY method available for entry into the 2013 U.S. Figure Skating qualifying competition season. Registration opens July 15, 2012.

2013 North Atlantic Regional Figure Skating Championships

To enter online into the 2013 qualifying competition season, proceed in the following manner:

- Log on to www.usfsaonline.org
- Input your membership number and password
 - If you do not already have a password, go to www.usfsaonline.org first and follow the online instructions.

B. DEADLINES

The entry deadline for the 2013 qualifying competition season is **11:59 p.m., Sept. 1, 2012**. The time zone of your primary residence/principle training center (juvenile, intermediate) or home club (novice, junior, senior) will determine the entry deadline of 11:59 p.m., Sept. 1, 2012.

NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.

NO LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DEADLINE.

Juvenile and Intermediate Singles Competitors ONLY:

During the online registration process, you will be given the option to input your principle training center if you wish to compete out of the region you train rather than the region in which your primary residence is listed. The following guidelines must be followed:

- You must train at your principle training center at least six (6) months and one (1) day during the calendar year to be eligible
- The region you select is binding (whether it is based on primary residence or principle training center) and cannot be changed.

Age requirements must be met by **Sept. 1, 2012**.

Test requirements must also be met by **Sept. 1, 2012**. Provisional entries based on passing a test after the closing date of entries will not be accepted. Please refer to U.S. Figure Skating Rules 2420-2423 for further testing information and guidelines.

*Skaters entering a singles event in addition to a partnered event must enter a regional championship within the section they have chosen for the partnered event.

C. ENTRY FEES

All competitors entering the 2013 qualifying competition season must submit payment of the \$175 entry fee to U.S. Figure Skating. All competitors are required to pay both the entry fee into the qualifying competition season (for each event entered) and an administration fee, which is \$10.

Sectional Championships Qualifying Entry Fees

Singles skaters advancing from the regional championships to the sectional championships will incur an additional \$175 entry fee and a \$10 administration fee. This total will automatically be charged using the same credit card used to pay for entry into the qualifying season. Skaters receiving byes or who advance per the four or fewer rule will NOT incur any additional entry or administrative fees.

Your registration is not considered valid until all appropriate entry and administrative fees are paid and all required forms (including the planned program content sheet) are completed online to U.S. Figure Skating.

D. PAYMENT

Online payment via credit card is the ONLY accepted form of payment.

For those competitors advancing to the sectional championships from the regional championships, the credit card used during the initial entry registration will be automatically charged the additional sectional entry fee. If an alternative method must be used for the sectional entry fee, please contact Lindsay Mulvey, U.S. Figure Skating, at 719.635.5200.

Once entered, all withdrawals are considered final. A skater may not reenter even if the withdrawal occurs prior to the entry deadline on Sept. 1, 2012. Please note: refunds are not given for any reason. *If you need to withdraw, you must send an email to Gia Witmer at gwitmer@usfigureskating.org, with your name, U.S. Figure Skating membership number, event in which you were entered (i.e. Junior Ladies) and the competition from which you wish to withdraw.

E. BYES

No medical byes will be considered. Competitors awarded a bye to their sectional championships or the U.S. Championships will receive official notification in writing from U.S. Figure Skating. All competitors wishing to compete in the 2013 qualifying competition season, including those who receive a bye, must enter by the Sept. 1, 2012, deadline. Please refer to the most recent U.S. Figure Skating rulebook for details on byes.

3. TECHNICAL DETAILS

A. CONDUCT OF EVENTS

For the 2013 season, all events and levels at all championship competitions (regional, sectional, U.S. Championships) will be conducted in accordance with the international judging system (IJS). Check the U.S. Figure Skating website for technical and/or rules updates.

B. AGE AND TEST QUALIFICATIONS

All age and test requirements can be found in the U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook starting with Rule 4200 (senior singles).

C. TECHNICAL ELEMENTS

The well-balanced program charts for all levels and disciplines are posted on the U.S. Figure Skating web site at http://www.usfigureskating.org/New_Judging.asp?id=355. As referenced earlier in this announcement, U.S. Figure Skating will incorporate all changes made by the ISU with regard to well-balanced programs. Please refer to this web site often for continuous updates.

PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT SHEET (Required component)

All competitors entering into the 2013 qualifying competition season are required as part of their online registration to submit a planned program content sheet (PPCS) detailing the elements in their program(s). You may update your PPCS at www.usfsaonline.org up to two weeks prior to the start of your competition. Failure to do so creates extra work for the officials working your competition. **You will not be allowed to receive your credential at registration until your PPCS is submitted.**

D. MUSIC

COMPETITION MUSIC INFORMATION (Required component of online registration)

U.S. Figure Skating requires all competitors to fully complete a competition music information form as part of the online registration process.

The following information is required for each piece of music used in the composition of the short program and free skate: composer, orchestra, duration of music, record label/number (optional but highly recommended if obtainable).

COMPACT DISCS (CDs)

For all qualifying events during the 2013 season, CDs are the only acceptable media. CDs must be:

- Clearly marked with name (last name, first name), event entered and the music time/length.
- **Each CD must have only ONE (1) track on it. In the case of a short program and free program, two (2) separate discs must be used.** Any disc with more than one (1) track will NOT be accepted!
- Lead in time (time before the music begins) on CDs may not exceed two (2) seconds.
- **Due to compatibility and reliability reasons, music may NOT be submitted on re-recordable "CD-RW" discs.**
- Each CD must be turned in - in a paper CD sleeve with a see through window (obtainable at any office supply store), also labeled with the skater's name and event.
- Standard hard plastic jewel cases or other CD holders are no longer acceptable. CDs that are not properly identified will NOT be accepted.

Competition music must be turned in at the registration desk at the time of registration. At the Championships, competitors will not receive their credentials at registration until they turn in their music. The originals will not be kept and forwarded on from Regionals to Sectionals; rather the Music committee will make digital copies at each event to pass the music up to the next level of competition. The music CD's will be returned to the competitors at the end of their final event. Each competitor that qualifies for Sectionals or the 2013 U.S. Figure Skating Championships will be required to bring CD copies to the next event as backup.

2013 North Atlantic Regional Figure Skating Championships

Skaters receiving byes to the U.S. Championships are required to email their competition music no later than one (1) month (Dec. 19, 2012) prior to the start of the U.S. Championships to the following email address:

All competitors must have at least one (1) additional copy rink-side at practice sessions and during the actual competition event. Skaters receiving byes must also bring CD copies of their music to the event as backup. The LOC will accept no responsibility for damage or loss. CDs not picked up by the end of the competition are not the responsibility of the LOC and will be discarded.

E. SEEDING AND QUALIFYING ROUNDS AT REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Any skaters who are added to an event due to unforeseen circumstances will be added to one of the groups (which group will be at the discretion of the chief referee) up to 48 hours before the start of the first qualifying group in that event. No reseeding or reassignments between groups will be made after the competitors are notified of their qualifying groups. Posting of the start order will be on the LOC website or the arena. The official schedule of events will be posted at the competition.

F. OFFICIAL BULLETIN BOARD/EVENT WEBSITE

The official bulletin board and event website will contain any announcements or changes, and it is the responsibility of the competitors to check often for official notices. Please refer to the local portion of the announcement for further information regarding the bulletin board and event website.

4. ADVANCEMENT TO SECTIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS/U.S. CHAMPIONSHIPS

A. QUALIFIERS

SINGLES COMPETITORS

All singles competitors advancing to the sectional championships or the U.S. Championships will receive instructions for downloading the specific event announcement from www.usfsaonline.org for the competition to which they have advanced.

For every competitor, all information required to be sent to the sectional championships or U.S. Figure Skating Championships local organizing committees (photos, practice ice requests, etc.) must be postmarked no later than the deadline on the respective form.

For those competitors receiving a bye to the sectional championships, you will receive either instructions for downloading the announcement or your announcement via email and must follow the deadlines set forth by the LOC.

B. ALTERNATES

Skaters placing in fifth and sixth place (unless there are fill-ins) at the regional championships in the juvenile, intermediate, novice, junior and senior singles events will be designated as first and second alternates. These competitors will be provided access to an event announcement as they may be selected to compete up to 48 hours before their competition event.

Alternates DO NOT need to mail in any paperwork or required forms unless contacted by U.S. Figure Skating.

5. INSURANCE/LIABILITY

A. LIABILITY

U.S. Figure Skating, the host club(s) and/or interclub association, the organizing committee, and the ice arenas being utilized for these events accept no responsibility for injury or damage sustained by any participant in these championships (U.S. Figure Skating Rule 1600).

6. ANTI-DOPING

Anti-doping tests will be conducted at the 2013 Prudential U.S. Figure Skating Championships, held in Omaha, Neb., Jan. 20-27, 2013. Anti-Doping testing will be conducted in the Senior-level and consist of the top four place-winners plus one random selection for each discipline. If selected, testing is mandatory.

DEADLINES FOR FORMS

The entry deadline for the 2013 North Atlantic Regional Championships is **11:59 p.m., Sept. 1, 2012**. The time zone of your primary residence/principle training center (juvenile, intermediate) or home club (novice, junior, senior) will determine the entry deadline of 11:59 p.m., Sept. 1, 2012. Registration entries must be submitted at www.usfsaonline.org.

All skaters must submit the forms provided in this LOC portion of the announcement. You can complete the forms online at www.icehousenj.fsc.org and for payment be directed to PayPal. The credentials form, practice ice form, All Event Tickets form, and program photos and or ads must be submitted and paid by **September 1, 2012.**

VENUE

The 2013 North Atlantic Regional Championships will be held at the Ice House, located at 111 Midtown Bridge Approach, Hackensack, New Jersey, 07601. The facility has four indoor ice surfaces, each measuring 200 x 85 ft with slightly rounded corners. Competition will be conducted on two surfaces. Judges will be seated on the side opposite the audience and skaters will enter the ice from the zamboni end of the ice. 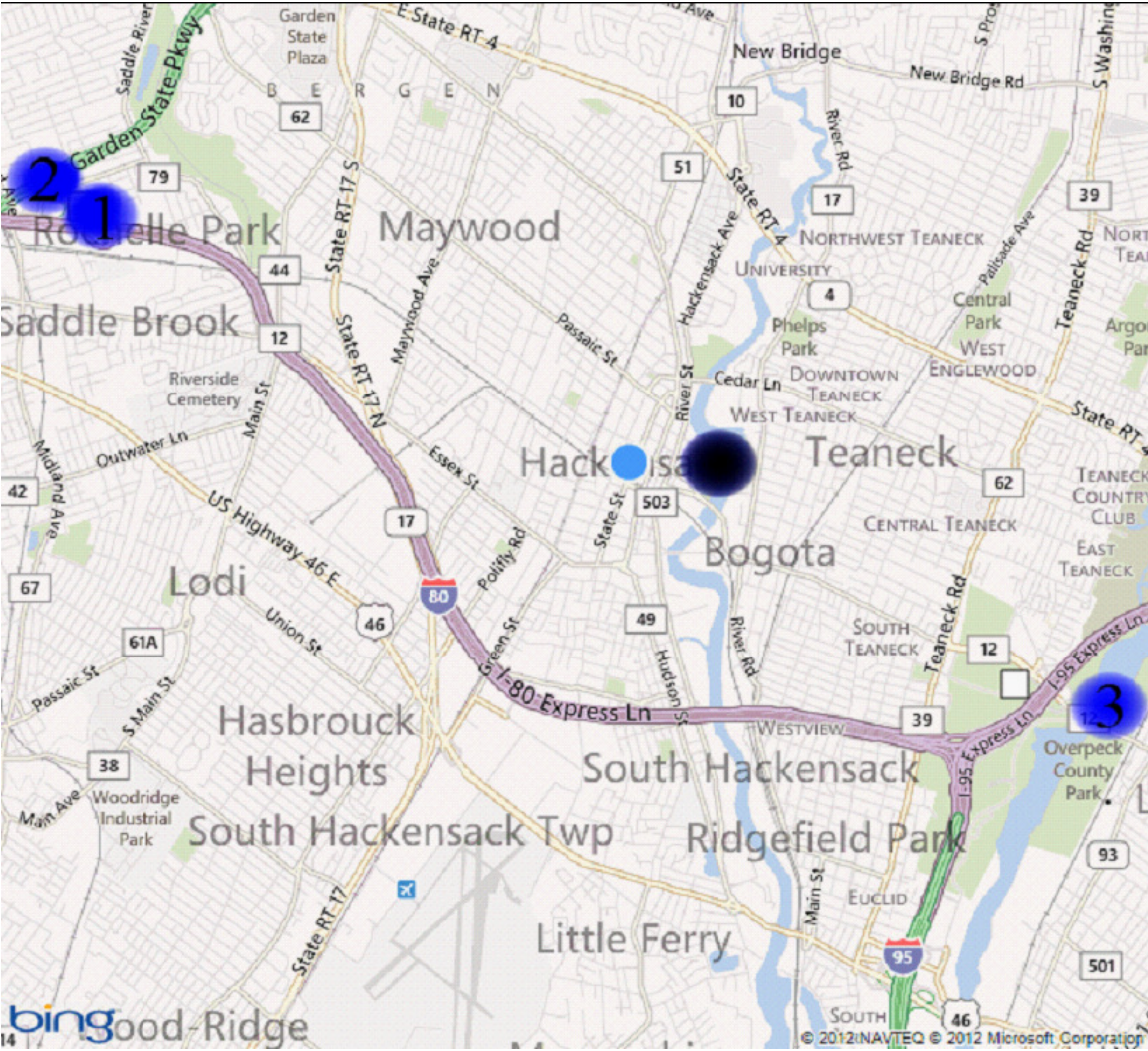

TRANSPORTATION

Visitors arriving by air should fly into the Newark International Airport in Newark, NJ, approximately 30 minutes south of the rink and the hotels. The other major airports with an hour drive are LaGuardia and Kennedy located in New York. Refer to the enclosed map for general directions. Competitors are responsible for their own transportation.

REGISTRATION DESK

A registration desk will be open in the lobby area of the Ice House from Friday, October 5, 2012 through Tuesday, October 9, 2012, during all practice and competition hours. Competitors must check in at the registration desk at least one hour prior to their scheduled events. Competitors must turn in music to receive their credentials and other information.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

A tentative and official Schedule of Events will be posted on www.icehouseNJFSC.Org and www.IceHouseNJ.com, as well as at the Ice House. Schedules will not be mailed to individual participants. Because the schedule is subject to change, participants should check the web site regularly prior to the start of the competition and check the official bulletin board at the arena throughout the competition.

OFFICIAL NOTICES

During the competition, updates will be posted on the official results bulletin board at the Ice House. Information on this bulletin board supersedes all other official information and is considered sufficient notice to all participants. It is the responsibility of the skater, parent, and coach to check this board upon arrival and regularly during the competition for changes of schedule or other important information.

VENDOR INFORMATION

Vendors wanting to set up a table at the Ice House for the 2013 North Atlantic Regional Championships should contact Edward Vancampen at icesk8boy@aol.com. The Ice House vendor fee is \$50.00 a day paid in advance. The Ice House can supply a vendor with one table for \$10.00 a day.

SECURITY / CREDENTIALS

Entrance to the competition arena is by credential or ticket only.

* **Competitors:** Each regional championships competitor will receive a credential for no additional charge.

- **Coaches:** One coach credential will be provided for each skater for no additional charge. This credential will allow entry to all areas of the venue. Coaches must be current members of U.S. Figure Skating, PSA, have completed necessary CER's and have coach's registration to receive credentials.
- **Chaperone:** One chaperone credential will be provided for each skater for no additional charge.
- **Additional chaperone:** Each competitor may purchase one additional chaperone credential for \$37.50 each (sales tax included).
- **Additional coach:** Each competitor may purchase one additional coach credential for \$37.50 each (sales tax included). Coach must be on approved coaches list.
- **Changes:** Competitors may make one change to chaperone and/or coach designations; these must be made at the registration desk by the non-minor skater or his/her parent or guardian.
- **Replacement:** Lost credentials may be replaced for \$37.50 each (sales tax included).

TICKETS

General admission to the competition is free for children 5 and under, \$7.50 per day for 6-12 years old, and \$15 per day for 13 and older. Day passes will be available for purchase at the rink on the same day as admission. All-event (multi-day) tickets may be purchased in advance for \$37.50 each (sales tax included) by September 1, 2012.

PRACTICE ICE

Official practice ice sessions will begin on Friday, October 5, 2012 at the Ice House. All official practice sessions will be 35 minutes for \$25.00. A skaters entire program music will be played during official practice session. Music will be played according to a random draw. Official practice ice may be reserved in advance with pre-payment. The practice ice schedule and assignments will be posted on www.IceHouseNJ.com and at www.icehouseNJFSC.org.

UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE

Unofficial practice ice will be offered as ice time permits. The days and times will be determined as the competition schedule is finalized. Skaters may request unofficial practice ice by going to www.icehousenjFSC.org or by signing up at the practice ice desk at the rink starting on Friday, October 5, 2012. No unofficial practice ice reservations will be accepted without payment. The fee for each 35 minute unofficial practice is \$25.00 per skater. Music will not be played on unofficial practice. There will be enough practice ice for everyone. One or two practice ice surfaces will be utilized all day.

PROGRAM

All skaters must submit a Program Photo form and a head/shoulders photograph for inclusion in the program. Electronic photos (jpeg) and form info must be emailed to Sue Reid at: SSReid1@aol.com.

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded for first through fourth place in all qualifying and championship rounds, and trophies will be awarded to the first place winners in the championship rounds. Results are not official until posted. Medalists should appear in costume and skates at the designated awards area on the ice for podium photos and to receive important information for the 2013 Eastern Sectional Championships.

VIDEOGRAPHY

The Event Video Company (EVC) will serve as the official videographer for all U.S. Figure Skating qualifying competitions for the 2013 competition season. EVC will provide professional videotaping services for all events. Please note: videotaping of the competition, including practice ice, in any form is strictly prohibited per U.S. Figure Skating policy.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Personal photography is permitted for personal use only and resale of purchased photos is strictly prohibited. No flash photography is allowed.
