State law requires that each school district creates and maintains a bullying policy and communicates that policy to its parents, guardians, and students each year.

Bullying, intimidation, and harassment diminish a student's ability to learn and a school's ability to educate. Preventing students from engaging in these disruptive behaviors is an important goal in District 123. Our Social Worker, Mrs. Hernandez, engages all of our students throughout the year with anti-bullying presentations. She clarifies with students the differences between bullying and conflicts.

Cyberbullying is a growing concern for many parents and students. It is an indirect form of social bullying that uses technological communications to humiliate, harass, tease, intimidate, threaten or slander one or more individuals. What children (and parents!) put on Facebook can be considered bullying due to the chosen words and tone of the message.

Students and parents are encouraged to assist in preventing harassment by reporting any incidents of alleged bullying/harassment to the building principal.
