Entry Fees:

Regular Classes \$20.00

Hunter Classic, Pleasure Classic, Stakes \$35.00

1. Judges' decisions are final. Anyone wishing to speak with a judge must first obtain permission from the show steward
2. Show management reserves the right to further cancel, combine, or divided classes when deemed necessary to facilitate the smooth running of the show.
3. Prize and/or cash plus 6 ribbons will be awarded in each class unless otherwise noted.
4. All returned checks will be charged a \$25.00 surcharge fee IN ADDITION to any bank fees charged by the show's bank.
5. Refunds of entry fees will not be made unless a veterinarian or a doctor's certificate is presented to the show office no later than the day of the show. Refunds will be made for classes that are canceled.
6. Every animal entered for competition will be under control of the Horse Show Committee; but the Saddle Rowe Farm, NETSA, CynTin, and any of its employees will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall sign the entry blank holding the show blameless for any loss, accident, or decision which may occur. First entrance into the ring as an exhibitor shall be construed as his/her acceptance of the rules of the show, should the exhibitor fail to sign entry blank
7. All dogs must be on a leash!
8. To be eligible for Championships, Rider must have shown in previous classes in that division

Horse owners who do not have access to a Thoroughbred's Certificate of Foal Registration and who are not able to successfully research a Thoroughbred's tattoo may apply to The Jockey Club for assistance with identification of the horse. This should be done well in advance of the horse show. If The Jockey Club is able to identify the horse, a letter will be provided that may suffice for proof of registration for participation in T.I.P.
6. For horses that are not tattooed, please send an **Email request** for assistance to tjctip@jockeyclub.com. In the email include all known information about the horse, including name, age, sex, color, sire, dam, breeder, last owner, racing history, and include 4 color photos be submitted showing the front, back and both sides of the horse as well as detailed photographs of any head markings or cowlicks.

The Jockey Club Thoroughbred Incentive Program (T.I.P.) Classes HUNTER DIVISIONS AND CLASSES

The Jockey Club Thoroughbred Incentive Program (T.I.P.) Thoroughbred Hunter divisions and classes are offered at this horse show under the following class and division conditions. The Jockey Club will provide the ribbon(s) to be awarded on the day of the show for each (T.I.P.) rated class and division and a prize for the winning rider of each division and the Hunter Classic

Also, a monetary purse will be given for each division and the Hunter Classic. Each T.I.P. Hunter Division shall consist of three classes—two (2) over fences and one (1) under saddle. Hunter courses shall consist of at least seven (7) jumps, to be judged on manners, pace and way of going unless otherwise noted. Under saddle classes to be judged at the walk, trot and canter in both directions, and to be judged on manners, movement and way of going.

In order to be eligible for the purse, a division or classic must have a minimum of three entries. Divisions may be combined to meet the minimum number of entries and one purse will be paid for the combined division.
