# TADPOLES 3-5 YEARS | 9 AM - 4 PM • Full Day \$150 / week • Half-Day \$80 / week

Tadpole camp weeks will concentrate on introducing children to the outside world. Your child will enjoy weeks full of games, crafts and outdoor discoveries. A PEEC instructor plans the activities and oversees a maximum of 12 children with the help of camp counselors and volunteers.

# **JUNE 25 - 29**

# **BUGS & BLOOMS**

There's a remarkable world around us! Search the forests and fields to learn about the world of plants and insects. Campers will study flowers up close, plant seeds in a garden, and use bug nets to capture insects.

# **JULY 2 – 6**

# FANTASTIC FROGS

Tadpoles will find, catch, and learn all about the frogs and amphibians that live around PEEC. We'll explore the ponds, and streams, and search all through the woods for these amaizng creatures.

# **JULY 9 - 13**

# **ECO-EXPLORERS**

We'll flip over logs, look into dirt, and turn over rocks in search of animals and the signs they leave behind. The children will be nature investigators that learn how all things in nature are connected.
