You are ineligible to receive financial aid for the 2014-2015 academic year. You may request to file an appeal for reinstatement of your financial aid. Please carefully read and follow the instructions listed below. Your application will not be accepted if all steps are not complete.

- Appeal Deadline: Fall Semester October 17, 2014
  Appeal Deadline: Spring Semester March 13, 2015
  Forms received after this date will not be accepted.
- 2. **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR SCHOOL CHARGES.** Payments must be received by the deadline to ensure your registration. If your appeal is approved, and you are awarded financial aid, you will be reimbursed for your school cost.
- 3. **Documents Required** 
  - A) Extenuating Circumstances Appeal:

You may request a reevaluation of your federal financial aid suspension based on extenuating circumstances such as:

- Serious personal illness or injury of student
- Death or illness of a family member
- Unexpected employment or work issues
- B) **Provide supporting Documentation for your extenuating circumstances**Provide supporting documentation of your extenuating circumstances on official letterhead. We cannot contact any medical staff agency or persons about your condition.

Please Note: Your appeal will be reviewed by the Financial Aid Service Committee

- C) Statement:
  - Explain your failure to maintain satisfactory academic progress
  - What corrective action you have taken or will take to improve your performance
- D) Complete Life Skills Lessons (page 4) Submit confirmation page



- 4. Maximum Credit Appeal:
  - You may request a reevaluation of your federal financial aid eligibility based on unique circumstances that created the maximum credits situation.
- 5. You will receive a response in approximately 4-6 weeks. Please check your MyUH portal and your hawaii.edu email account.
- 6. Once you have submitted your Satisfactory Academic Progress Appeal Form, the Satisfactory Academic Progress Appeal form will be evaluated. If approved, we will send you an Academic Plan. Please review this plan with your Advisor and submit this form to the Financial Aid Services. The form must be signed by both you and your Advisor.
- 7. If this Academic Plan is not signed and submitted, you will not be eligible for financial aid.


