

New Role

Role contains the SSIS security functions that are directly linked to what you are able to view and do in SSIS. The Role defines what you are able to perform. A user is assigned to a Role according to duties and responsibilities.

Creating a limited number of Roles makes the Security Administration more effective and manageable.



Hint: There are established templates in the Role List. These are designated with SSIS- in the beginning of the title.



To access Role List:

1. Log onto **SSIS Admin** and select **Lists** from the Windows toolbar.
2. Select **Role List**.

Role Screen



To add or edit a Role:

1. Click **New**. The Role screen displays.
- OR
1. Select a **Role** from the list and double-click or click the **Edit** button.
 2. Enter a **Name** for the new Role.
 3. Click the **Add** button in the Users section.
 4. Select the **User(s)** to assign to the Role and click the **OK** button.



Hints:

- Roles can also be assigned to a specific user on the User Profile. Refer to New Unit or User Profile cheat sheets.
- Multi-select option is available in the Select Users screen and the Profile section. By using the **Shift** key or **Ctrl** key you can multi-select and click the **OK** button to assign.



Add Functions to Role:

1. Select a template for the new role by **selecting an existing role** in the List functions for role field.
- OR
2. Leave default of **<<Show all functions>>** to view all security functions available.
 3. In the Available Functions field, select the **security functions** to assign to the role and click the **Add >** button.
 4. Once all security functions are assigned, click **OK**.



Remove Functions from Role:

1. In the Assigned Functions section, select the **security functions** to remove from the role and click the **<Remove** button.
2. Once all security functions are removed, click **OK**.



Hint: Use the Add All >> or <<Remove All buttons to add or remove all functions.



To Delete a current Role:

1. Select the **Role** from the list and click the **Delete** button.
2. Click **OK** on the warning dialog box.
