# Instructions

Use this form when you have a financial interest in a vehicle and need to obtain the personal information from DMV's vehicle record in order to obtain a release of interest or a signature required for a title transaction.

Do not use this form to request personal information from the record of a vehicle that is abandoned on your property or that you are required by law to give notice on.

This form and the evidence of interest that you submit do not:

## a. guarantee disclosure of the personal information requested, or

### b. establish an ownership in the vehicle for title issuance purposes.

- The form must be complete, **notarized**, and legible. The vehicle information must include at least the Oregon plate number or vehicle identification number.
- 2. Attach **copies** of the document(s) that are evidence of your interest in the vehicle. **Do not send originals**, as the documents you submit **will not** be returned.

### The evidence of interest that you submit must:

- a. include a description of the vehicle (at least the Oregon plate number or vehicle identification number),
- b. include your name, and
- c. show that you have an interest in the vehicle.

3. Send the completed form and copies of your evidence of interest to:

4. Your request will be reviewed. If DMV is satisfied that you have financial interest in the vehicle, the information will be mailed to you.
