Contest open to Grade 11 and 12 students (during the 2009-2010 school year) of Jean Vanier High School, Collingwood Ontario. <u>A minimum of three entries must be received before the scholarship will be</u> offered. Deadlines may be extended at the discretion of the Reunion Committee.

Prize: \$1000

- Submission to Jean Vanier School Office by 4 p.m. June 14, 2010 of *Intent to Write* form, *Intent to Write* form is Appendix 1.
- Completed 1 hard copy and 1 electronic copy and signed Interview consent forms submitted to Jean Vanier School Office by 4 p. m, September 15, 2010.
- Essays will be judged using the Scoring Guide in Appendix 2. Essays will be judged by blind review (i.e. no names will appear on the Judges' copies).
- Length : 1200-1500 words, double spaced, 12 font, Times New Roman .
- For the purposes of this essay competition, the following definitions will be used. Primary source is a information given by a source that has direct, personal experience (e.g. a past principal or a trustee, a personal journal). A Secondary source is information that builds on, cites or comments on a primary source
- Winners announced by September 30, 2010
- At least 2 primary sources to be used in this historical research. Interview consent forms to be signed and attached if individuals are interviewed. A sample is in Appendix 3.
- All essays become the exclusive property of the Our Lady of the Assumption School 50th Anniversary & Reunion Committee (Reunion Committee) to be used in activities related to this event.
- The Essay is intended to be historically accurate. The essay may be a chronological history of important events and the participation of families or persons in these events. Alternately the essay may be an indepth study into a person, family or event that was particularly significant to OLA.
- The Essay is also intended to convey emotional appeal for the topic. 2
