

Refund Policy

Training Descriptions



American Red Cross CPR Training is in compliance with the Emergency Cardiovascular Care 2000 Guidelines. You will learn to: call and work with EMS, recognize and care for breathing and cardiac emergencies that call for CPR, perform CPR and care for breathing and cardiac emergencies, avoid bloodborne pathogen exposure and know the role of AEDs in the cardiac chain of survival. Participants who complete the skills and written tests successfully will receive a one-year certification.

American Red Cross First Aid Training is in compliance with OSHA standards. This class will teach you how to: recognize emergency situations, check the scene and call for help, avoid bloodborne pathogen exposure, care for wounds, bone and soft-tissue injuries, head and spinal injuries, burns, heat and cold emergencies. Learn to manage sudden illnesses, stroke, seizure, bites, poisoning and minimize shock. Participants who complete the skills and written tests successfully will receive a three-year certification.

Automated External Defibrillator. Sudden cardiac arrest (SCA) is a leading cause of death in the United States, claiming approximately 250,000 lives each year. When SCA strikes, seconds mean the difference between life and death. With each minute of elapsed time, the survival rate diminishes by approximately 10 percent. Now, with the latest generation of portable automated external defibrillators (AEDs) and training from your American Red Cross, you will be prepared to increase the odds of survival if SCA strikes. AED training teaches anyone how to respond to victims of SCA and deliver the lifesaving electric shock that can return the heart to its normal rhythm. Participants will learn how today's AEDs are easy to use, thereby minimizing response anxiety. Automated External Defibrillator training is taught with all Adult CPR classes.

Which class should you take?

- -If you want to know what to do in an emergency to protect your family, friends or anyone... you are a daycare provider, childcare business owner or pursuing a daycare provider licenses... if you are planning to become a CPR and First Aid Instructor you should take *Adult/AED*, *Child*, *Infant CPR and First Aid Class*.
- -If you have a duty to act in an emergency, for example: Health care professionals, nursing students, law enforcement, EMT, firefighters, etc. you should take *CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer*.
- -If you need to have the training because your job complies with OSHA; you should take Adult CPR/AED and First Aid.
- -If you have current certification that is about to expire, you may renew your certification with a review course of **Receptification**
- -If you have current certification or your certification has expired, you may renew your certification through a challenge course by successfully passing both the written and skills test without any practice or coaching. You should take *CPR and First Aid Challenge*.

More Safety Training Solutions for your workplace or facility

Protect your most valuable assets-your employees. Consider the cost of an accident or illness and you will see that safety training is an investment that pays for itself time and again. Safety training can help you contain the expenses associated with on-the-job injuries and illnesses. When it comes to the American Red Cross, you know you are getting the best training available.

Designed for companies of any size, these courses teach emergency response skills based on the latest scientific findings, as stated in the ECC 2000 Guidelines and OSHA First Aid Guidelines. The Lancaster County Red Cross representative will work with you to ensure that course content targets specific issues in your workplace.

Depending on your needs, courses can be presented at your location or your local Red Cross chapter house. Classes can be scheduled to meet your needs. If you have six or more participants we will come to your location and teach your fellow employees on-site.

Adult CPR/AED, Child and Infant CPR and First Aid Training

Combines all of the classes mentioned above in one complete training course. This is an excellent choice if you expect to take all levels of CPR and First Aid. Books are included and will be given to you by the instructor the first night of the class you register for. Successful completion of the class will certify the student for three years in First Aid and one year in CPR/AED. If you only need an Adult/AED CPR class, you can register for any of the classes listed below-Adult/AED CPR is taught the first four hours of any class, or typically the first day. If you only need a First Aid class, they are taught the last four hours of any class or typically the last day of a three-day class. Your American Red Cross Representative can help you register if you have questions. CPR, First Aid books and skills cards are available in Spanish.

CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer

This class is designed for any individual who has a duty to respond to emergencies. This class teaches one and two person method of CPR, AED and resuscitation and bag-valve mask. Books and CPR masks are included. Successful completion of this class will certify the student for one year in CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer.

Do you need a speaker at your next event or company meeting?

The American Red Cross can provide speakers for one-hour "lunch-n-learn" sessions, education for company meetings, health fairs, etc. These are non-certification classes. Topics can include: Basic First Aid, CPR and AED. The cost is \$50 per hour plus the cost of any books or materials.

Injury-Control Modules teach skills for reducing costly workplace injuries and illnesses

Focusing on common causes of worksite injuries and key health risks, these one-hour awareness-level modules highlight risks and promote prevention. Self-assessments help employees recognize risky habits. Demonstrations and lively discussions reinforce practical prevention tips. You can schedule these modules as add-ons to any workplace-training course, or make them a "brown bag" lunchtime event open to employees. Participants receive certificates of attendance. The cost is \$50 per one-hour presentation plus \$2.00 per book per student, books are required. Topics include:

Ergonomics + Slips, Trips and Falls + Back Injury Prevention
Workplace Violence Awareness + Managing Stress + Your Heart Matters

CPR and First Aid Challenge

The challenge class is an option for those whose certification is about to expire or if you have a certification from another agency and you require American Red Cross Certification. Persons attending this class should feel comfortable completing the written and skills test without any practice or formal review. Participants can test in Adult, Child and Infant CPR, AED, First Aid and Professional Rescuer CPR. Professional Rescue participants need to bring their own CPR masks to class. Masks can be purchased at the American Red Cross, Monday through Friday 9:00-4:30. Successful completion of this class will certify the student for one year in CPR/AED and three years in First Aid.

CPR and First Aid Re-Certification

This class is an option for those whose CPR certification is about to expire. You must show proof of current certification, American Heart Association acceptable within one year of initial training. This class provides a short review and practice before testing. You can test in Adult, Child and Infant CPR, AED, Professional Rescuer CPR and First Aid. **Professional Rescuer participants need to bring their own CPR masks to class.** Successful completion of this class will certify the student for one year in CPR/AED and three years in First Aid.

CPR/AED and First Aid Instructor



This course trains candidates and gives them the tools necessary to teach the following components: Adult/AED, Infant and Child CPR and First Aid. Current certification is not required, however candidates must have held student level certification within the last two years. Crossover examination required for Professional Rescuer CPR. Students must attend all sessions and pass the course to receive certification. Please call our offices for further information. \$100.00 per student / 16 hours.

Preventing Disease Transmission (Bloodborne pathogens)

This course combines lecture, demonstrations and video to build awareness of bloodborne pathogens and teach exposure-prevention skills. This course meets OSHA requirements for bloodborne pathogens. \$50.00 per presentation <u>plus</u> \$2.00 per student for book(s) (books are required), 2 hours. *Books also available in Spanish.*

HIV/AIDS Education

To train individuals to share facts about HIV and AIDS accurately, non-judgmentally and sensitively with people from diverse groups and communities and to learn how to encourage people to apply those facts to their own behavior.
