You will be notified by April 17, 2014 of whether or not you have been accepted as a teacher. Please note that if you are invited to work at the Museum, teachers must attend one training and orientation session on either May 13, 2014 or May 14, 2014. This mandatory teacher orientation will begin at 5:30pm in Classroom 4.
