Brief Description

Two clinics in one! This is an advanced clinic, for teams desiring to learn information that may come up in the Hippology Contest and wanting to practice for the Horse Judging Contest. The morning session will be focused on Hippology topics, and the afternoon session will focus on Horse Judging. Topics to be discussed in the morning may include nutrition, anatomy, parasites, feed ingredients, etc. This information will be helpful during the test, stations, and team problems phases. In the afternoon, both live and video mock judging classes will be presented in the areas of both halter and performance. Participants will have the opportunity to practice placing classes, discuss official placings, and receive assistance in preparing oral reasons. This clinic is open to both junior and senior 4-Her's as well as adults.

Please note: there is no guarantee that all of the information presented will appear in the Hippology contest. There is also no guarantee that the horse judging classes used in the clinic will be the same ones used in the contest. However, no horses used in the clinic will be used in the contest.
