In addition to discussing major issues prevalent in our communities such as the growing demand for culturally sensitive, quality health care access, the conference will emphasize the need for Latinos in leadership positions in all branches of healthcare. Furthermore, LMSA will continue to honor graduating seniors, as well as distinguished individuals throughout various conference events, including the Graduating Senior Gala on the evening of Saturday March 22nd.
