With an eye on the future, funding will be needed for the Stroke Center, the Joint Institute, the Spine Institute, continuing staff education and acquiring state-of-the-art equipment like the da Vinci Robotic Surgery System and more powerful MRI and CT Scans already in place. Charitable Gifts

Ways of Giving

There are a number of ways for interested donors to make contributions to the Foundation in addition to outright cash gifts. Gifts of securities, real estate, gifts-in-kind and planned gifts are equally welcome. These contributions may also result in tax savings that go beyond the traditional straight tax deduction for outright giving. Gifts may also be made in memory of a loved one or friend or to commemorate a special occasion.



Annual Giving

The Annual Giving Campaign is an opportunity to donate to the CMC Foundation to provide sustained, ongoing support for the mission of the hospital. This mission includes a commitment to provide quality health care in the hospital and to develop programs and services to help meet the health care needs of our communities. Programs like The Lighthouse and The Center for Kids & Family are addressing everyday problems faced by seniors, young families, children, teenagers and adults.

Memorial/Honor Gifts

A gift in honor or memory of a beloved friend or associate can be the most appropriate way to express a lasting tribute. To honor someone at an important milestone in his or her life, for instance a birthday or anniversary, is also an ideal way to give a special gift to that person.

If a gift or gifts collectively in one person's name total \$1,000 or more, the individual's name is permanently placed on a special plaque that is displayed in the hospital. Each honor or memorial gift is acknowledged with a card to that person or to the family of that person in whose name the gift is made. Notification does not include the amount of the gift.

Horizon Club

The Horizon Club is a donor club that recognizes the people who believe in quality health care today, and in the future. To become a member, you only need to inform the Foundation that you have made, or intend to make, a planned gift to Community Medical Center. These gifts may be made through bequests in your will, charitable gift annuities, charitable trusts, life insurance, life estates or to the pooled income fund. In addition to benefiting the Medical Center, these gifts often reduce tax liability and/or increase income for the donor. The amount of a bequest or trust is entirely your choice and will be kept strictly confidential.

Members of the Horizon Club are invited to special programs, which offer an inside look at Community Medical Center and the Saint Barnabas Health Care System. They also receive special updates on the Medical Center and health care in general. Horizon Club members' names are listed, with their permission, in the Annual Gift Report and on the Horizon Club plaque located in the Medical Center. The Foundation staff can be a resource for information regarding all aspects of charitable gift planning.

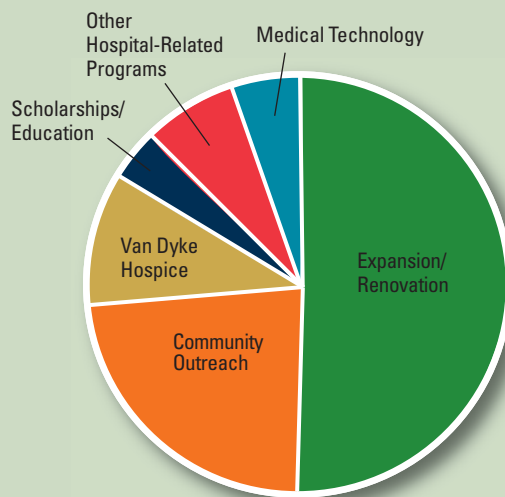
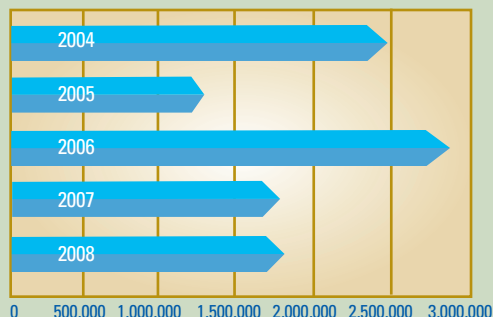
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**Foundation Disbursements
