

TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL UNITS

Effective June 1, 2010, all registered adults must complete Youth Protection Training every two years. Beginning with rechartering for 2012 (completed in December 2011), the Top Leader of each unit must be Trained for their position or the unit will not be allowed to recharter. Top Leader, as defined by the national office, is Cubmaster, Scoutmaster, Varsity Team Coach, Venturing Crew Advisor, and Skipper.

2. A revised MB counselor information form to include a space for emails, the counselor's BSA ID No., as well as a place indicating that a copy of the counselor's Youth Protection Training Certificate must be attached. This form needs to be filled out annually and takes a few minutes to do.

3. Youth protection training MUST be up-to-date. This is BSA requirement and the counselor must attach a copy when they take the form to the Council office to be processed.
