Osteogenesis Imperfecta....

Osteogenesis imperfecta (OI) is a genetic bone disorder characterized by fragile bones that break easily. It is also known as "brittle bone disease". Rolling over in bed or sneezing can cause a fracture. In addition to frequent fractures, other symptoms can include loss of hearing, brittle teeth, or respiratory difficulties. There is no cure for OI yet, which affects an estimated 25,000 - 50,000 people in the United States.

The Osteogenesis Imperfecta (OI) Foundation began in 1970. The Foundation's mission is to improve the quality of life for people affected by OI through research to find treatments and a cure, education, awareness, and mutual support. The OI Foundation holds a Biennial National Conference for families impacted by OI; produces informational fact sheets, books, and other resources, and funds approximately \$1 million in research each year.
