




- 8 a.m.: Set-up and registration begins

Cascades Avenue is only accessed from Park Drive. If coming from the north on Canal Street, turn left on Church (Albertsons Grocery on left corner), then drive to the end, turn right on Park, then right on Cascades. If coming from the south on Canal, turn right on Greene Street (Hwy 62/180), then left as you cross the railroad tracks immediately before the bridge, and left again on Cascades. NCKRI HQ is the first building on the right. A sculpture of Jim White faces the river, and the entrance is at the opposite end of the building. Drive to the end of Cascades, then turn right into the paved parking lot or left into the gravel parking lot, which is closer to NCKRI's entrance.

Starting at the traffic light in front of WalMart on Canal Street on the south side of Carlsbad, drive south 0.3 miles to where Highway 285 turns off to the left; make that left turn (there is a traffic light) and drive another 1.3 miles to Thomason. Turn right on Thomason. You're heading slightly out of town and there is little street lighting so watch your mileage closely. Follow Thomason 2.0 miles south to Hopi. Danielle's house (actually it is her folks' house and they are also hosting us) is on the left on the northeast corner of Thomason and Hopi. The house faces Thomason but turn left onto Hopi and park near the driveway or on the street wherever you can find room. Hopi does not connect to the National Parks Highway as shown on the map, but you can reach Thomason via Chapman.
