Lakeview Elementary School PTA SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Lakeview Elementary School PTA offers scholarship(s), as permitted by the approved budget, to graduating Byron Nelson High School, Northwest High School or Steel Accelerated High School seniors who will be enrolled in an accredited college or university or a technical/vocational institute in the summer or fall semester immediately following his/her high school graduation. **Applicants must have attended Lakeview Elementary School.** Funds for the scholarships come from Lakeview Elementary School PTA membership fees, fundraising, and community sponsorships.

Purpose of Scholarship

The purpose is to support Byron Nelson High School, Northwest High School and Steel Accelerated High School students who are focused on achieving career goals through higher education. In evaluating each application, the scholarship committee will also consider service and participation in school activities, community involvement and scholastic merit.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicant must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior from Byron Nelson High School, Northwest High School or Steel Accelerated High School.
- Applicant must be a member of the Byron Nelson High School, Northwest High School or Steel Accelerated High School PTSA. Applicant's name must be on the current membership list as of March 1, 2014 - (Membership form available on PTSA web site, in front office and school store.)
- Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited college or university or a technical/vocational institute in the summer or fall semester immediately following his/her high school graduation.
- A completed application and required documents must be received by April 1, 2014 to be eligible for consideration.

Selection and Notification

Selection is made by a Selection Panel and processed by the Scholarship Committee of the Lakeview Elementary School PTA. Recipients will be acknowledged during the Senior Royal awards. Applicant(s) chosen to receive a Scholarship must submit a copy of their acceptance letter from the educational institution to the Lakeview Elementary School PTA Treasurer June 20, 2014. Upon receipt, a check for the scholarship amount will be sent directly to the educational institution.

All entries submitted to Lakeview Elementary School PTA become the property of Lakeview Elementary School PTA and will not be returned.
