- Early registration for Fall 2012 begins **Monday, April 2, 2012**
- Prepare your packet of information.
  - Use a folder or binder to contain materials.
  - Make sure your cover sheet is complete and clearly visible.
  - Rank your preference for ADES 2630 section:
    - *ADES 2630.501*      8:00 a.m. to 10:50 a.m.
    - *ADES 2630.504*    11:00 a.m. to 1:50 p.m.
    - *ADES 2630.503*      5:00 p.m. to 7:50 p.m.
- Beginning April 2, you may drop off your packet to the **Design Department Office, AB 237.**
- Your materials will be reviewed.
- If all requirements are met, an enrollment code will be emailed to you.

**NOTE:** You must also register for **ART 2350 Art History Survey I.**  
This is a requirement for submitting for the Entry Review in December 2012.  
**If ART 2350 does not appear on your transcript, you will not be eligible for the Fall 2012 review.**
